The Latin text was written by Saint Thomas Aquinas in the 13th century for the Feast of Corpus Christi, a celebration of the body and blood of Jesus Christ. French composer, organist and teacher César Franck set the text to music as a part of his Messe à trois voix. Opus 12 (Mass for three voices). Franck's composition was first published in 1872.
