Devotional Guide: “Time Well Spent”

Theme Verse: Ephesians 5:15-17 ESV

¹⁵ Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, ¹⁶ ***making the best use of the time***, because the days are evil. ¹⁷ Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.

Day 1: Time Is a Gift, It's Not Guaranteed.

Read: James 4:13–15

Reflect: Life is fragile and unpredictable. Time is not promised—it's entrusted.

Question: How do I treat time—as a gift or a guarantee?

Day 2: Time Reflect our Priorities & Reveal Purpose

Read: Matthew 6:33

Reflect: What we give time to shows what we value most.

Question: What does my calendar say about my priorities?

Day 3: Redeem the Time (Make the Most of Every Opportunity) – No Time to Waste!

Read: Ephesians 5:15–16

Reflect: Stewardship means using time wisely in a world full of distractions.

Question: What distractions steal my time from God's purpose?

Day 4: Jesus Modeled Time Stewardship

Read: John 9:4

Reflect: Jesus was never rushed, yet always purposeful.

Question: How can I model Jesus' rhythm of work, rest, and mission?

Day 5: Living with Eternal Perspective

Read: Colossians 3:1–2, Psalms 90:12

Reflect: Time stewardship means investing in things that last forever.

Question: What eternal investments am I making with my time?

Daily Prayer:

“Lord, help me to see time as a sacred trust. Teach me to number my days and live wisely. Show me how to honor You with every moment I'm given.”
