## Todd's Take

Welcome to worship! What a joy it is to gather together as a church family. To our guests joining us today, we'd love the opportunity to

As we gather as the church let us renew our commitment to the love of God and the love of our neighbor. Throughout The Messenger you can find ways to grow closer to one another, be in the Word, and serve our world. Let your heart be open to where God is calling you. If you have any questions, always feel free to reach out to us.

This morning we are back in 1 John. In today's text (2:15-17) John calls us to evaluate our loves.

Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them. For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever.

We will explore what John means by the word "world"; what characterizes love of the world; and his compelling argument to choose to love God above all.
