

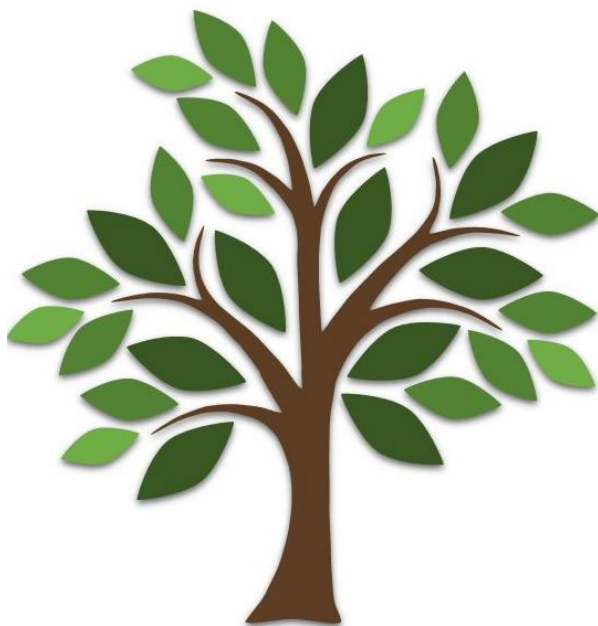

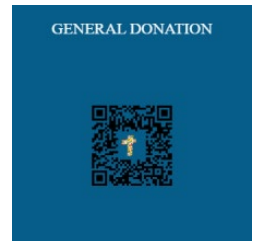
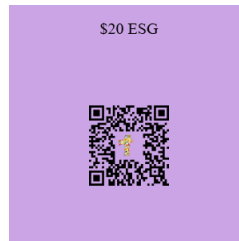

More Ways to Donate!

You may notice some new QR codes around the church. We are trying out an additional way to support the many good things happening in our community. Here's a quick overview:

- Still the best way to donate is through our [website](#), especially for recurring donations. These transactions happen through Sunergo, and have the benefit of being more convenient for making changes/updates to recurring donations easily
- Next best option: one-off or monthly bank transfers, which have no transaction fees. These can be arranged through our [Finance Manager](#)
- **NEW!** By scanning the new QR codes, you can make a one-time donation conveniently using ApplePay or GooglePay (provided you've set this up on your device). Choose the right QR code for your needs, depending on your preferred designated fund and donation value. This option will hopefully be more convenient for newcomers and visitors who are not yet in our Sunergo system.
- Last but not least: Watch for a new Tap2Pay system that will hopefully be in operation in time for this fall's ESG performance.

ESG Bottle Drive

The ESG Bottle Drive **continues!** The collection bin has been moved to the lower hall.

You can also **still** bring your empties to any Return-It Express Depot in BC yourself, and the funds will go directly to ESG. Here's how:



- Place all your unsorted containers in sealed, clear or transparent bags up to 90-litre capacity. **No sorting or counting necessary.**
- Go to a Return-It Depot and find the Express kiosk located on site. Use 604-203-1433 to log in.
- Print your labels, label your bags. Each bag needs a label.
- Scan the labels in your bags with the scanner (if available) at the Express kiosk.
- That's It! Return-It will sort and count the containers, and ESG will be credited with your deposit refund.
