Ben and Becca Johnson have been living and working in Chiang Mai, Thailand since 2015. During this time, they have studied Thai language and culture, helped in the planting of a church in Chiang Mai, and began building relationships with Thai people, both believers and unbelievers.



The theme of Ben and Becca’s ministry in Thailand is:
 Empowering Thai pastors . . .
 . . . to plant Thai churches . . .
 . . . that reach Thai people.

Ben and Becca are partnering with Thai churches and a Christian foundation to recruit, train, equip, send, and support teams of Thai church leaders to reach the parts of Thailand that need the gospel most.



Much of Ben's ministry involves working with Thai pastors (such as the two shown here with their wives) to equip them with theological training and resources, but also helping them practically in ways such as starting small businesses for family income, since many pastors need to be bi-vocational.

Ben and Becca and their family appreciate your prayers and support as they seek to follow God’s leading in this calling and make use of the opportunities that they have to see the Gospel go forth in planting and building faithful churches, especially in areas that are still without Gospel witness.

You'll also learn how to let the Bible provide the answers to someone's spiritual need as the Holy Spirit convicts and convinces the person through the power of God's Word. - **Various Subjects from the *Westminster Confession*** – The Westminster Catechisms (Shorter and Larger) comprehensively address various subjects within Christian theology, particularly from a Reformed perspective. Led by our Elders (West Wing)
