We are now one-quarter through our fiscal year, and each month our income has been below budget, which is a concerning pattern. Expenses in September were \$8,673 over budget, but this was expected because we paid our annual insurance premium of more than \$11,000 that month. Our monthly deficit of almost \$15,000 reduces the General Fund balance to just over \$65,600.

Our year-to-date expenses are about \$1,500 under budget, which is a good situation. However, our year-to-date income is now more than \$21,000 below budget. We need to see increased giving in the coming months. Our grade remains an A, but that will begin to decline if monthly deficits continue.
