

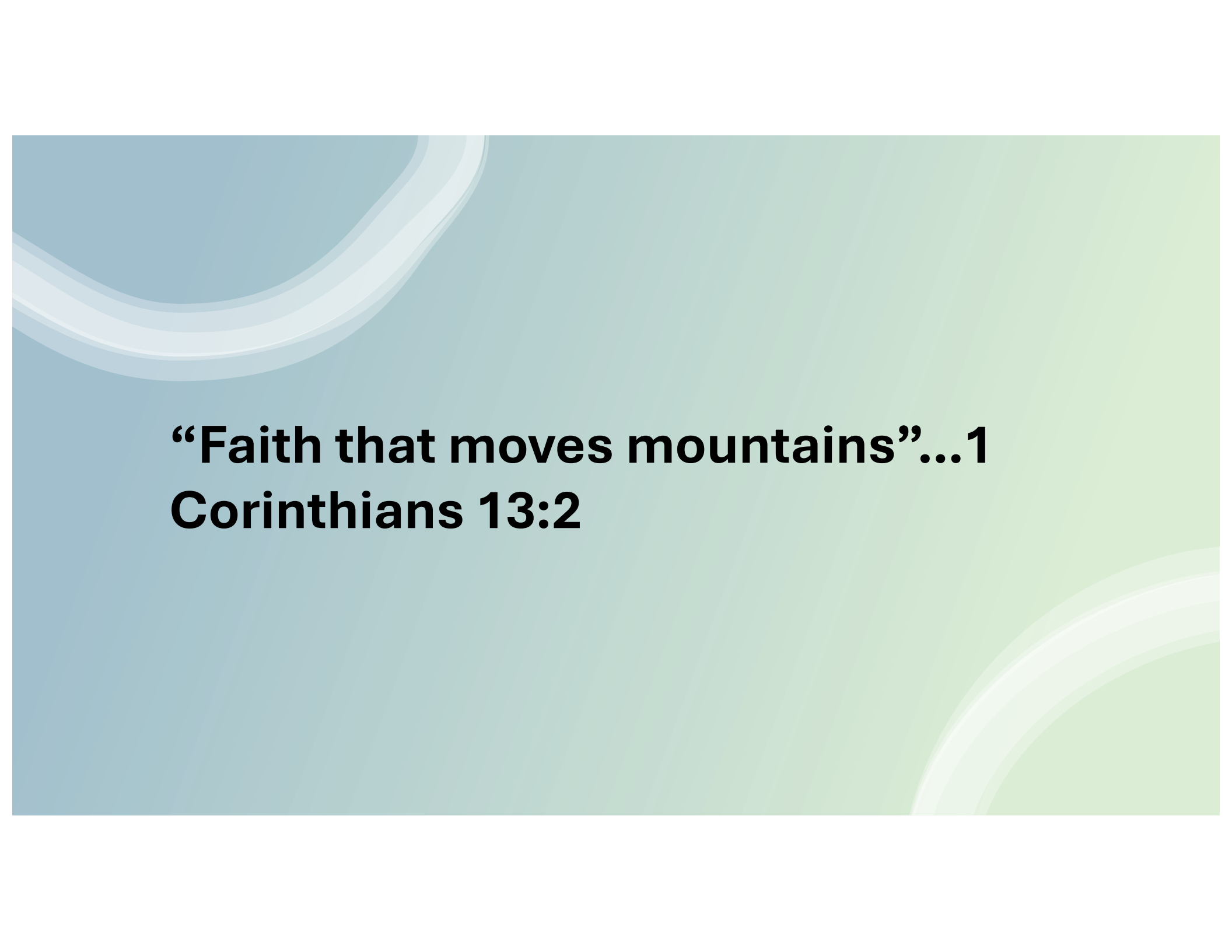

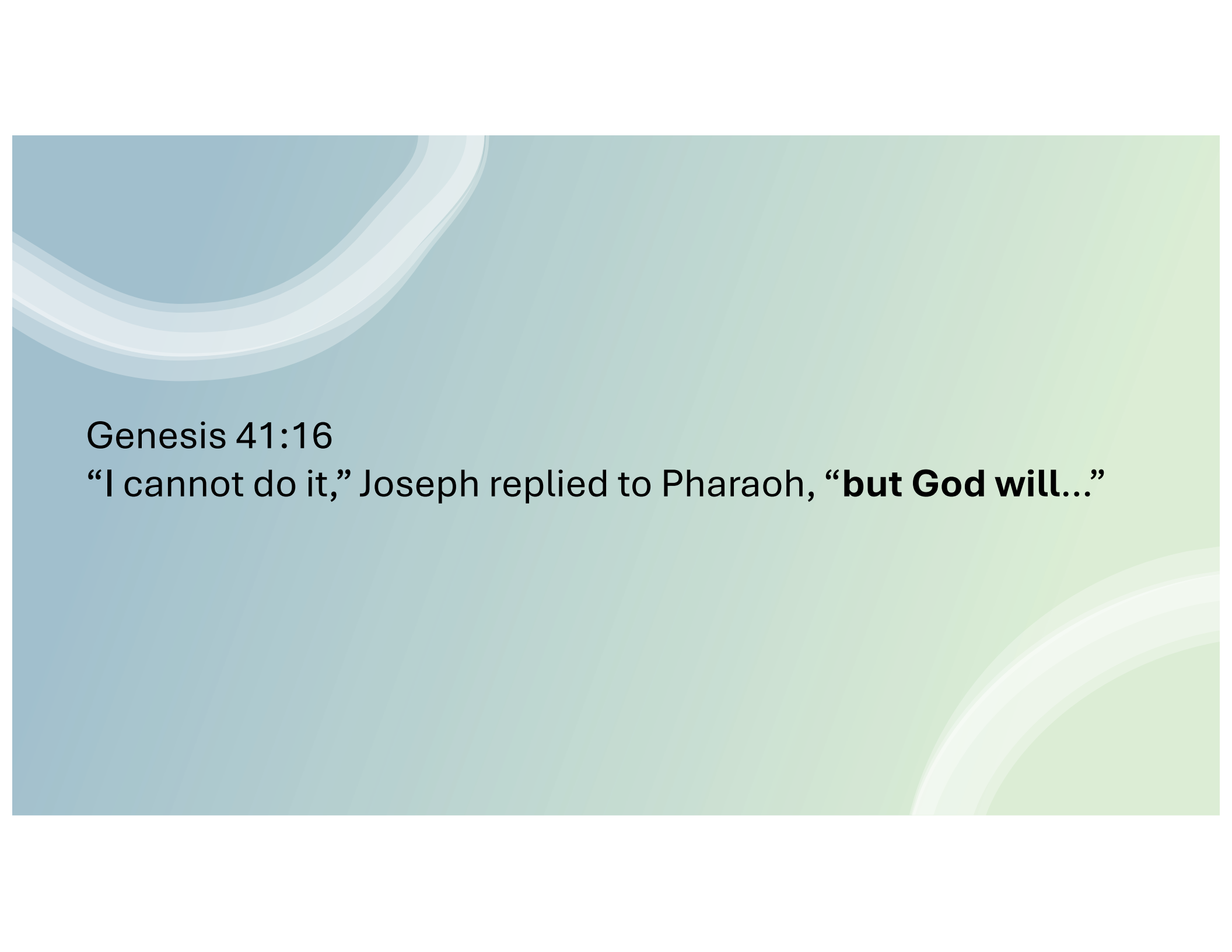
You are called to be a mountain mover!

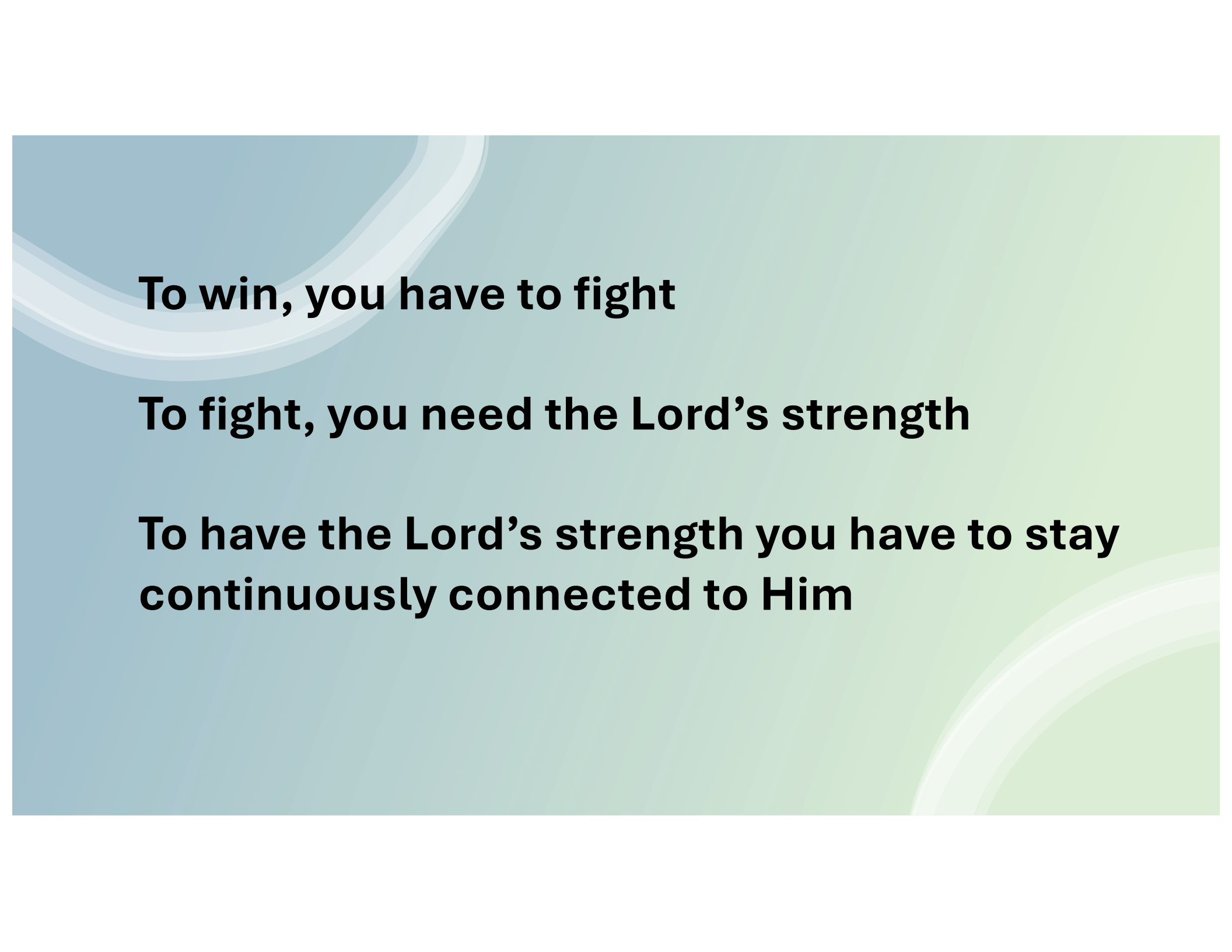

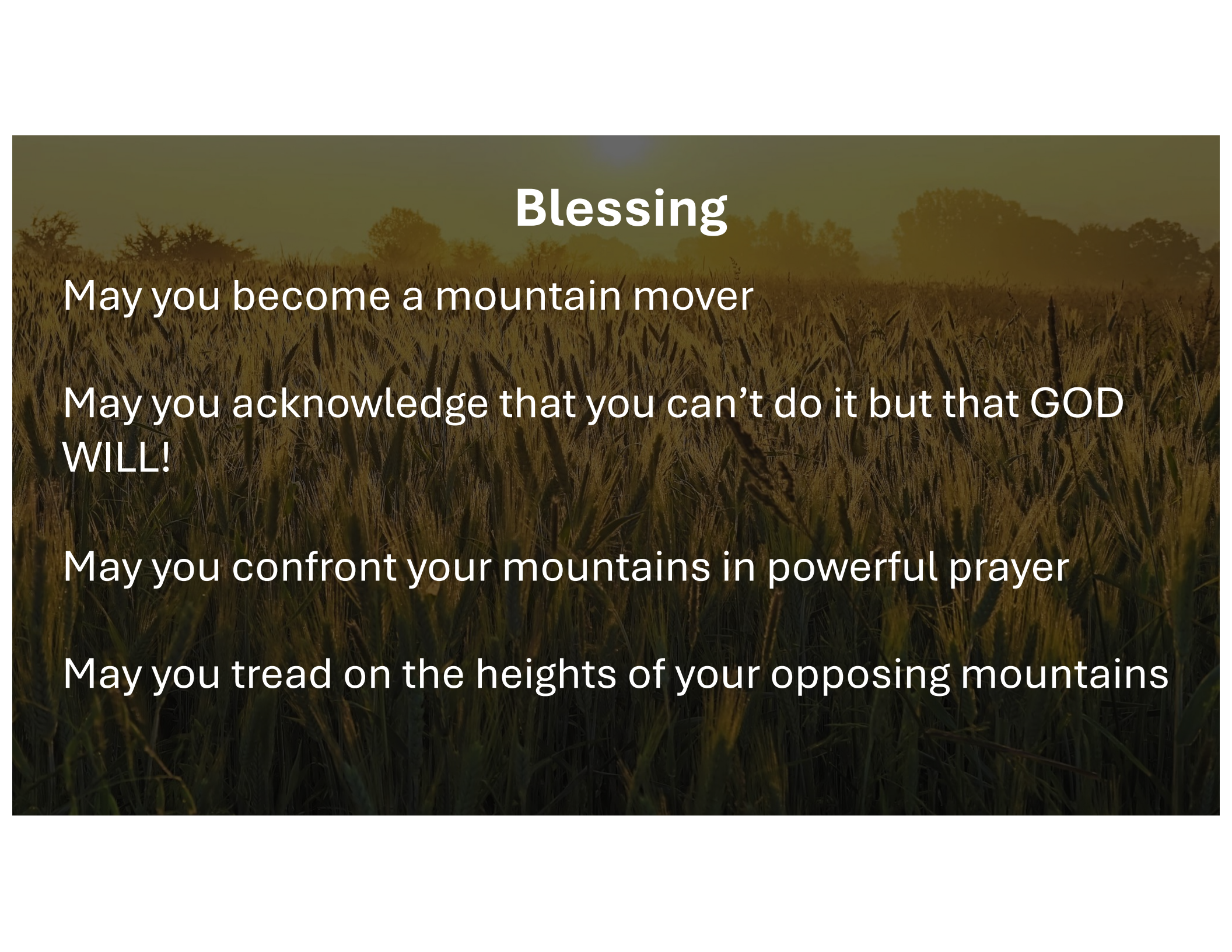
