- 6. What are some practical ways to build margin into a busy schedule?
- 7. What are some "consumer" mindsets or habits we can fall into at church without realizing it?
- 8. Where do you see God calling you to "play your part" in this season?
 - a. What <u>unique</u> gifts, skills, or passions could He use through you to build His church?
- 9. What are some potential barriers that might keep you from fully participating in God's work?
 - a. Examples: Busyness, leadership insecurity, past hurt, lack of clarity, etc.
- 10. What are the next steps we can take to shift from attendance to ownership, and consumers to contributors?
- 11. Pray for unity, teamwork, and ownership to increase at PCC.
