Ezekiel 10:11

The spirit of the Lord showed Ezeiel four cherubim with four wheels, one beside each cherubim. Each wheel was like a wheel intersecting a wheel. The wheels did not turn, and the cherubim went in the direction the head faced without turning their bodies. Their entire bodies were full of eyes. The man in the linen suit put a mark on the heads of those who grieved and lamented. Those without the mark were slain. This is

similar to Revelation where we will be given a white stone with a new name known only to the person who receives it. If we are to make good decisions, we must remember who we are following. Follow God with all your heart.
