WEEK 3 TOGETHER ON THE PATH

The Christian life was never meant to be walked alone. We are together on this path.

Fellowship (koinonia) means sharing something deeply significant in common.

Our shared faith—the gospel of Christ Jesus—is the glue that binds us together, even when we differ in background, age, status, or opinion.

Five realities we share in common that are deeply significant in spite of our differences as followers of Jesus Christ:

1. We have a shared identity.

1 John 3:1a

¹ "How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!"

2. We have a shared hope.

1 John 3:2

² "Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when He appears, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is."

3. We have a shared gift.

1 John 3:5

⁵ "But you know that He appeared so that He might take away our sins. And in Him is no sin."

1 John 3:6

⁶ "No one who lives in Him keeps on sinning. No one who continues to sin has either seen Him or known Him."

4. We have a shared enemy.
