1 John 2:15-16

- ¹⁵ Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
- ¹⁶ For everything in the world—the cravings of sinful man, the lust of his eyes and the boasting of what he has and does—comes not from the Father but from the world.

God loves the people of the world, but He's warning us not to love the ways of the world.

¹³ Enter through the narrow. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many will enter through it. ¹⁴ But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.
