# Words from Pastor Chris

Last month I mentioned briefly that we are planning to emphasize discipleship in a new way starting in January. We are looking to build a new discipleship group culture that leadership believes will provide greater accountability to the spiritual disciplines that promote spiritual growth. The goal is that the spiritual growth experienced in these groups will translate into a church filled with disciples who are also disciple makers themselves. If we are going to be a Great Commission focused church, then this must be the goal. This is where our church mission statement comes from as well. "Making disciples to live like Jesus to transform the world for Christ."

Leadership has also defined what we call a "dream disciple." We believe that at FBC Florala, spiritual growth that will take place in these D-Groups will lead to disciples who are:

- F Faithful Followers
- **B** Bold Witnesses
- C Christ-Like Servants
- F Fully Accountable



This is who we believe Christ wants us to be. The desire of this new discipleship culture is to help people grow in each of these areas. As we do, we will find ourselves being much more effective at being personal disciple makers.

The question for many I am sure though is what will this look like? We have trained over 20 group facilitators to lead these groups. Over the next few weeks, they will be reaching out to individuals to populate these groups. To achieve maximum effectiveness, these groups must be capped at 5-6 people. Groups will be gender specific. Groups will meet each week for around an hour. To join one of these groups we ask for strong commitment to the expectations. Each member of the group will be expected to read around 2 Bible chapters a day and do a brief journaling of that reading that we call H.E.A.R journaling. When the group meets, each member will share some of what they have journaled throughout the week. Another key component of these groups is Scripture memory. Each week, group members will be expected to memorize a specific passage and then recite that passage in whole group time. Group meetings will be designed to not only promote accountability to Scripture engagement but also to personal holiness and evangelism.

Many are probably wondering where we can fit one more thing into our already busy schedule. Our current plan is to have these groups meet on Sunday evenings, although there is flexibility. We will provide space at the church along with childcare. We need accountability to the things of Christ and these groups will provide it unlike any other ministry we offer. If someone asks you to join a group let me encourage you to simply say yes and see how Jesus will grow you into a stronger disciple who makes strong disciples.


