

MPC Hearing Assistance:

On Sunday, October 19th we started a 4 week trial of a new Hearing Assistance program from Listen Technologies. There will be limited devices to try but we would like as many people as possible to try out this new system and the different options. You may see people passing them around during the services.

For those with hearing aids there are two primary methods for using this WiFi based system:

- 1. Hearing Loop: This is a WiFi receiver with a loop that hangs around your neck and transmits the audio directly to a hearing aid or cochlear implant that uses T-Coil technology.
- 2. Smart Phone App: For those who are already able to send audio from your smart phone directly to your hearing aid. Use your phone to connect to the WiFi audio channel and transmit to your hearing aid.

WiFi Reciever: This is similar to the older FM receiver system but with much better sound quality. You simply plug in your own wired earbuds, headphones or bone conduction headphones. This WiFi receiver allows for <u>wired</u> devices.

Phone App for Wireless options: With the Listen Smart Phone app loaded on your phone (in PlayStore search for ListenWiFi) you connect to the MPC Audio WiFi channel and then use your own wireless earbuds or headphones.

What to expect: We know that depending on what type of connection you are using there will be milliseconds of delay possible. Similar to having two TV's in your house on the same channel (which are you hearing 1st or echo). We will be doing some fine tuning as we go for what works best in our sanctuary.

We need as many people as possible to try things out and see if it's something that works for you and please let someone from the Communications or EZW team know your thoughts or if you need help loading the app.

Important information regarding a proposed change to our By-Laws

At our Sunday, October 26, 2025, we will be discussing and voting on a proposed amendment to our By-Laws.

This proposed amendment was drafted by your 2025 Nominating Ministry Team and approved to be sent to the congregation for a vote by your Session.

What follows is the motion that the Nominating Ministry Team sent to Session:

This motion proposes an amendment to the current term lengths for members of Session, Deacons, and Trustees, changing them from two years to three years. We believe this adjustment will offer several significant benefits to our church and its leadership.

Current Situation:

Currently, members of Session, Deacons, and Trustees serve two-year terms. This requires frequent rotations and can sometimes lead to a lack of continuity in leadership and projects.

Proposed Change:

The Nomination Ministry Team makes a motion that the Church's bylaws be amended to extend the length of term for Deacon, Elder and Trustees from two year to three-year terms.

Rationale and Benefits:

1. Enhanced Continuity:

- A three-year term provides greater continuity in leadership.
- It will allow members to develop a deeper understanding of their roles and responsibilities.
- This continuity is especially beneficial for long-term projects and strategic planning.

2. Increased Efficiency:

- With a longer term, leaders will have more time to implement initiatives and see them through to completion.
- It will reduce the time spent on onboarding new members.
- Allows for a more efficient use of resources.

3. Deeper Engagement:

- A longer term enables members to develop stronger relationships with the congregation.
- A longer term enables them to gain a more comprehensive understanding of the church's needs.
- This fosters deeper engagement and commitment.

4. Improved Training and Development:

- A three-year term allows for more effective training and development opportunities for leaders.
- Ensures they are well-equipped to serve the church.

5. Reduced Turnover:

- Less frequent rotations reduce the administrative burden associated with elections and onboarding.
- Allows the church to focus on its mission.

Implementation:

If approved, we propose implementing this change through a phased approach to ensure a smooth transition. For example, we could stagger the terms so that only a portion of each body is replaced each year, maintaining continuity throughout the process.

Next Steps:

We request that Session consider this proposal and schedule a meeting to discuss it further. We are prepared to provide additional information and answer any questions you may have.

We believe that this change will strengthen our church's leadership and better equip us to serve our congregation and community.

Below are the current By-laws and then the changes to be made if this amendment passes.

The Session shall consist of six (6) Elders divided into classes of **three (3)**, one class of whom shall be elected each year at the annual meeting for a **two-year term**. No elder shall serve on the Session for consecutive terms either full or partial, aggregating more than six years; but shall be ineligible for election to a new term until one full year shall elapse.

The Board of Deacons shall consist of six (6) Deacons divided into classes of **three (3)** one class of whom shall be elected each year at the annual meeting for a **two-year term.** No Deacon shall serve on the board for consecutive terms, either full or partial, aggregating more than six years; but shall be ineligible for election to a new term until one full year shall elapse

The Board of Trustees shall consist of six (6) Trustees divided into class of **three (3)** one class of whom shall be elected each year at the annual adjourned meeting for a **two-year term.** No trustee shall serve on the board for consecutive terms, either full or partial, aggregating more than six years; but shall be ineligible for election to a new term until one full year shall elapse.

If proposed amendment passes the By-Laws will read:

The Session shall consist of six (6) Elders divided into classes of **two (2)** one class of whom shall be elected each year at the annual meeting for a **three-year term**. No elder shall serve on the Session for consecutive terms either full or partial, aggregating more than six years; but shall be ineligible for election to a new term until one full year shall elapse.

The Board of Deacons shall consist of six (6) Deacons divided into classes of **two (2)** one class of whom shall be elected each year at the annual meeting for a **three-year term**. No Deacon shall serve on the board for consecutive terms, either full or partial, aggregating more than six years; but shall be ineligible for election to a new term until one full year shall elapse

The Board of Trustees shall consist of six (6) Trustees divided into class of **two (2)** one class of whom shall be elected each year at the annual adjourned meeting for a **three-year term**. No trustee shall serve on the board for consecutive terms, either full or partial, aggregating more than six years; but shall be ineligible for election to a new term until one full year shall elapse.
