
WELCOME TO METROPOLITAN UNITED CHURCH

MUSIC NOTES

This morning, the Great Heart Youth Ensemble presents songs that express the desire for connection, in the midst of intimidating locales and confusing times. Matt Hire's *Tangled Web* and José González's *Stay Alive* both respond to urban alienation, fighting bleakness with hope and resolve. Stevie Wonder's *Visions* expresses the blind composer's resilience and faith, locating spirituality in the tactile. His *Jesus Children Of America*, composed in 1972, anticipates by decades the turbulence of an era in which faith has been weaponized for a savage politics. Green Day's *See the Light*, from their rock opera *21st Century Breakdown*, looks beyond political tribalism to more profound connections.


