CREATIVE RESPONSE

Jesus came as a guest to the house of Zacchaeus and brought salvation to his home (Luke 19:5-9).

- Purchase or prepare food to donate to a local food pantry assisting the poor.
- Organise a fundraiser and give the proceeds to a charity serving the disadvantaged.
