Communication Column

We are quickly moving toward November and of course that means Thanksgiving. Social media has many flaws but one of the things I enjoy about the month of November is that many people will post what they are thankful for each day during the month. Most of the time they list the "big things" that they are thankful for, things such as salvation, a family, a church family, friends, food, and a heavenly home. We definitely should be thankful for those things and not just during the month of November but all of the time. Yet we are called not just to be thankful for the big things but to be thankful in "all things". The Bible says in 1 Thessalonians 5 to "rejoice always, pray without ceasing and give thanks in ALL things, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." In other words we are to be thankful people, who depend on

God and rejoice in Him. This means that we aren't just thankful for the big things, but that we take time to be thankful for the small things as well. I remember when I pastored outside of Danville, Virginia, God was blessing the church and good things were happening. One Sunday I was talking with one of the older members after church and people were standing around talking after the service was over. He smiled, looked at me, and said "when people stand around and talk after church you know that things are good, we need to be thankful for even the small things." He had a lot of wisdom.

Last year (2024) in May I suffered a herniated disc in my back. Thankfully it healed fairly quickly or so I thought. By the end of the month I was having severe muscle spasms in my back that made it hard to walk, or to sit, or to lie down. Going up and down steps was almost impossible. In fact for 3 days I didn't leave the house, finally I was able to get downstairs and outside. I started physical therapy and today everything is great. Sometimes now when I'm going up or down the steps I just stop and take a moment to be thankful. Its a small thing, but we are to be thankful in the small things. I certainly don't get it right all the time but God in His grace reminds me occasionally of His goodness and I take time to be thankful.

God has blessed us in many ways. Certainly the greatest way is with Jesus and through the salvation that we have in Him. He blesses us with family, with church, with friends, and in so many other ways. These are things that we should be thankful for. When we come to worship and we are lifting up our voices in song, these are the things that we should be rejoicing in. The Bible says He lavishes His grace on us, and we see that in those big blessings, but we also see that in the small blessings of life. If all God ever did for us was save us through the blood of Jesus we would have reason to praise Him throughout all eternity, but because God is so good, He blesses us in so many other ways as well. So lets take time to be thankful all the time, for all of His blessings, the big, the small and the in-between because He is always worthy of our praise!
