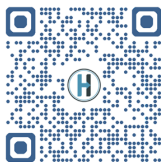

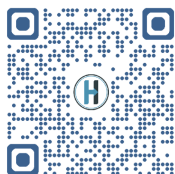

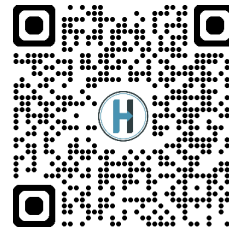
Save the Date ~ Women's Ministry
