Leviticus - Chapters 8-10

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What stood out to you from reading Leviticus 8-10? What stood out to you from Sunday's message? How did Jesus speak to you personally?
- 2. What is the significance of stating "as the Lord commanded," seven times, and particularly last time in 8.36?
- 3. Read the following passages from the book of Hebrews and discuss the corresponding questions:
 - Hebrews 7.23-28: How is Jesus a permanent High Priest? And how does reading Leviticus 8-10 help to appreciate Jesus more?
 - Hebrews 9.11-13: What did the sacrifice of animals accomplish? What did Jesus' sacrifice accomplish?
 - Hebrews 4.14-16: How does Jesus as our High Priest help us? What is an example of an everyday life moment where this reality could help someone?
- 4. Read 1 Peter 2.4-5 and Revelation 1.5-6. In what ways do you, or could you, have a priestly ministry?
- 5. Christmas Party Discussion: Step 1) Take turns telling each other about your own local mission field (people you see regularly here who don't know Jesus yet) name names! Step 2) As a group brainstorm some kind of Christmas Outreach (we encourage a party!) your group could do to connect with people in your collective mission field. Today is about brainstorming; in future weeks we will set plans and prepare. Pray and ask God to lead your group.
