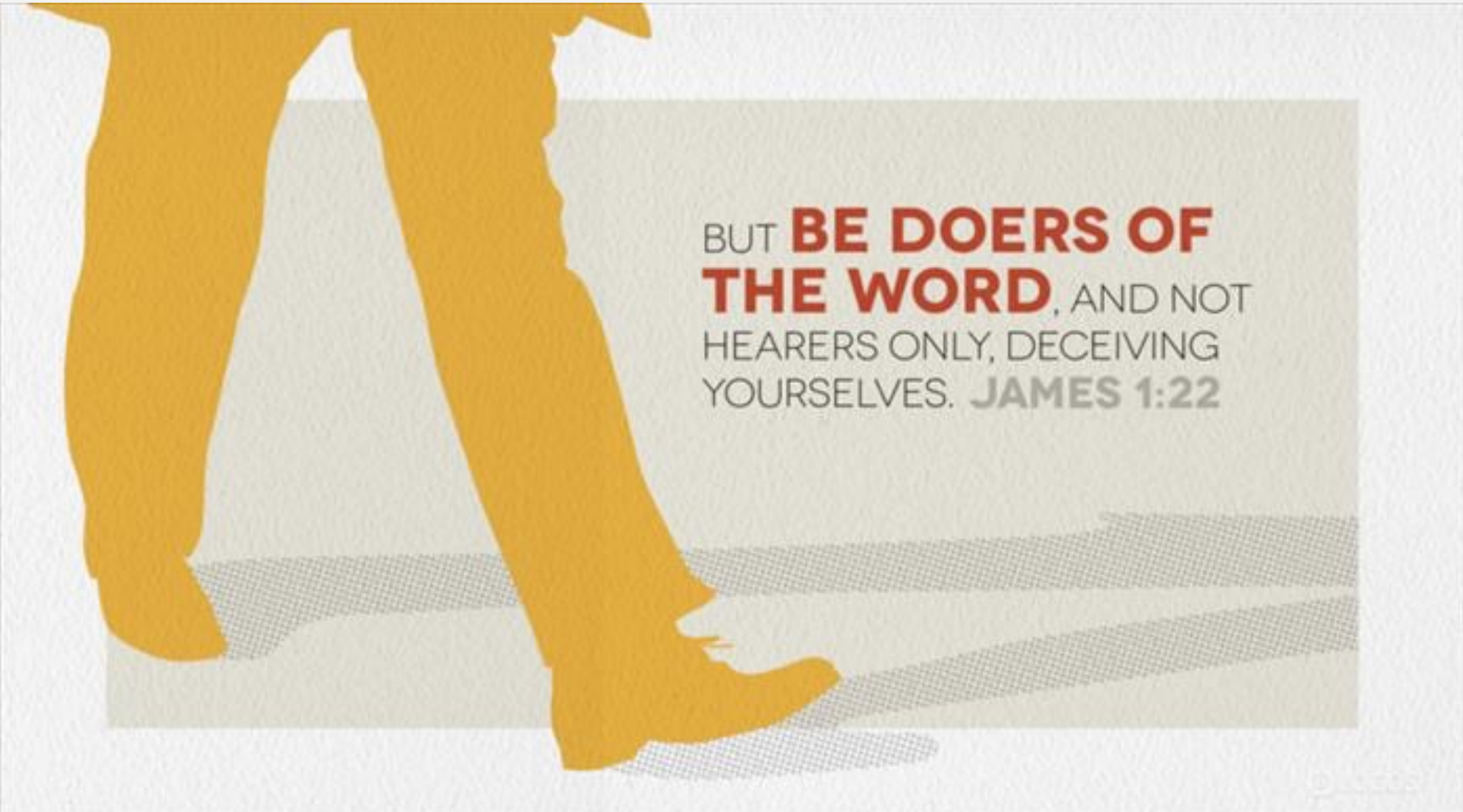

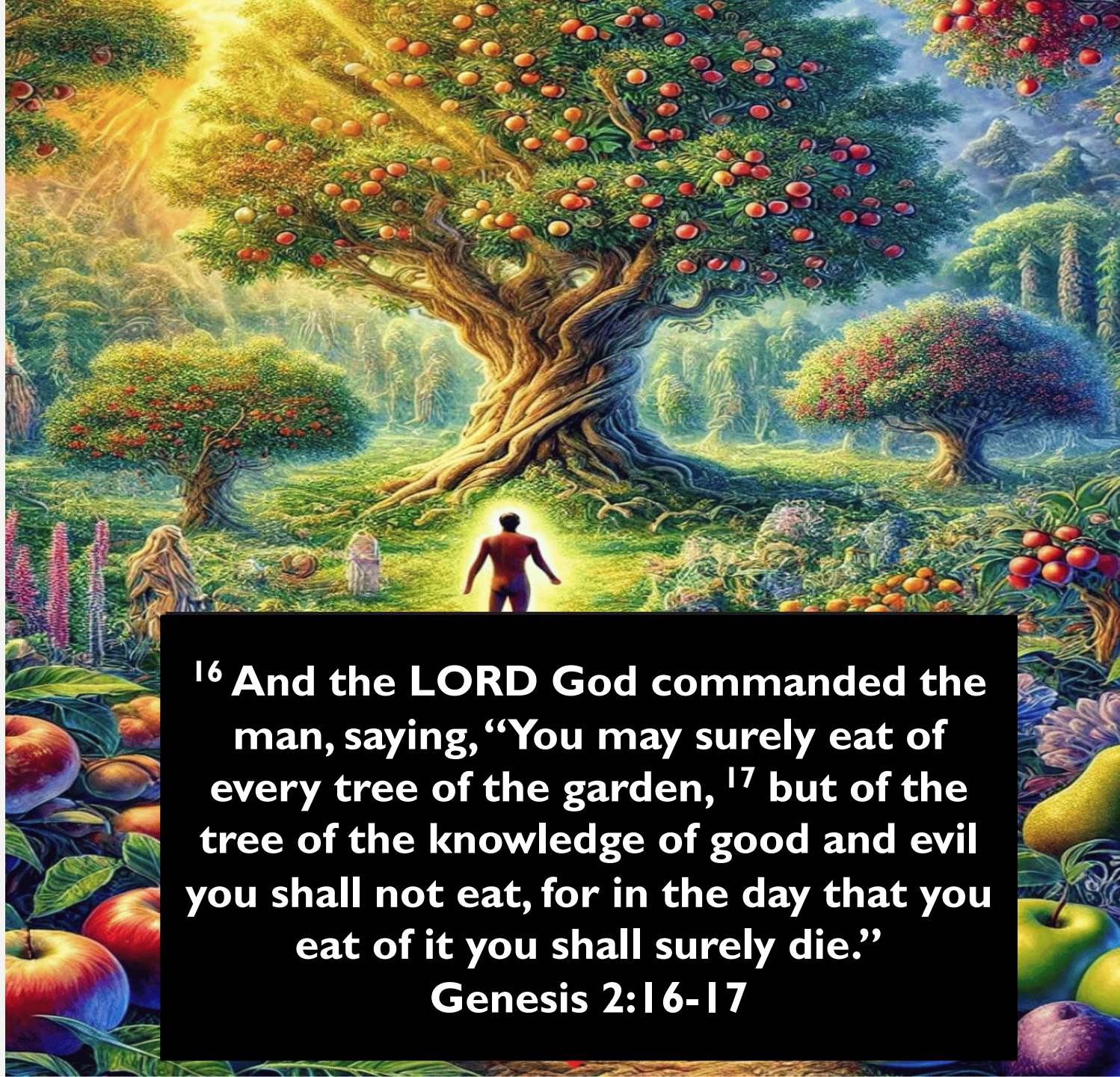

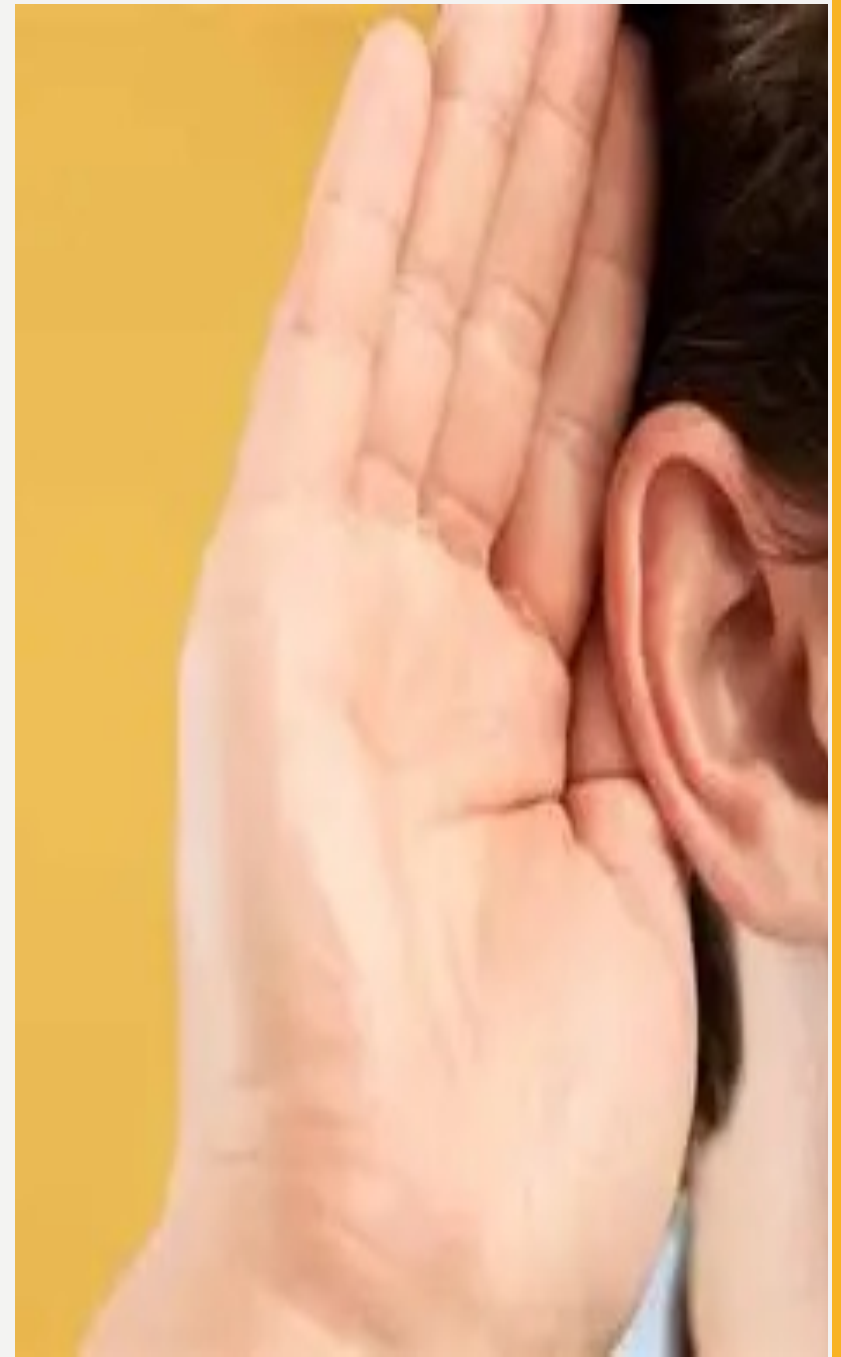
DEUTERONOMY 6:3-12

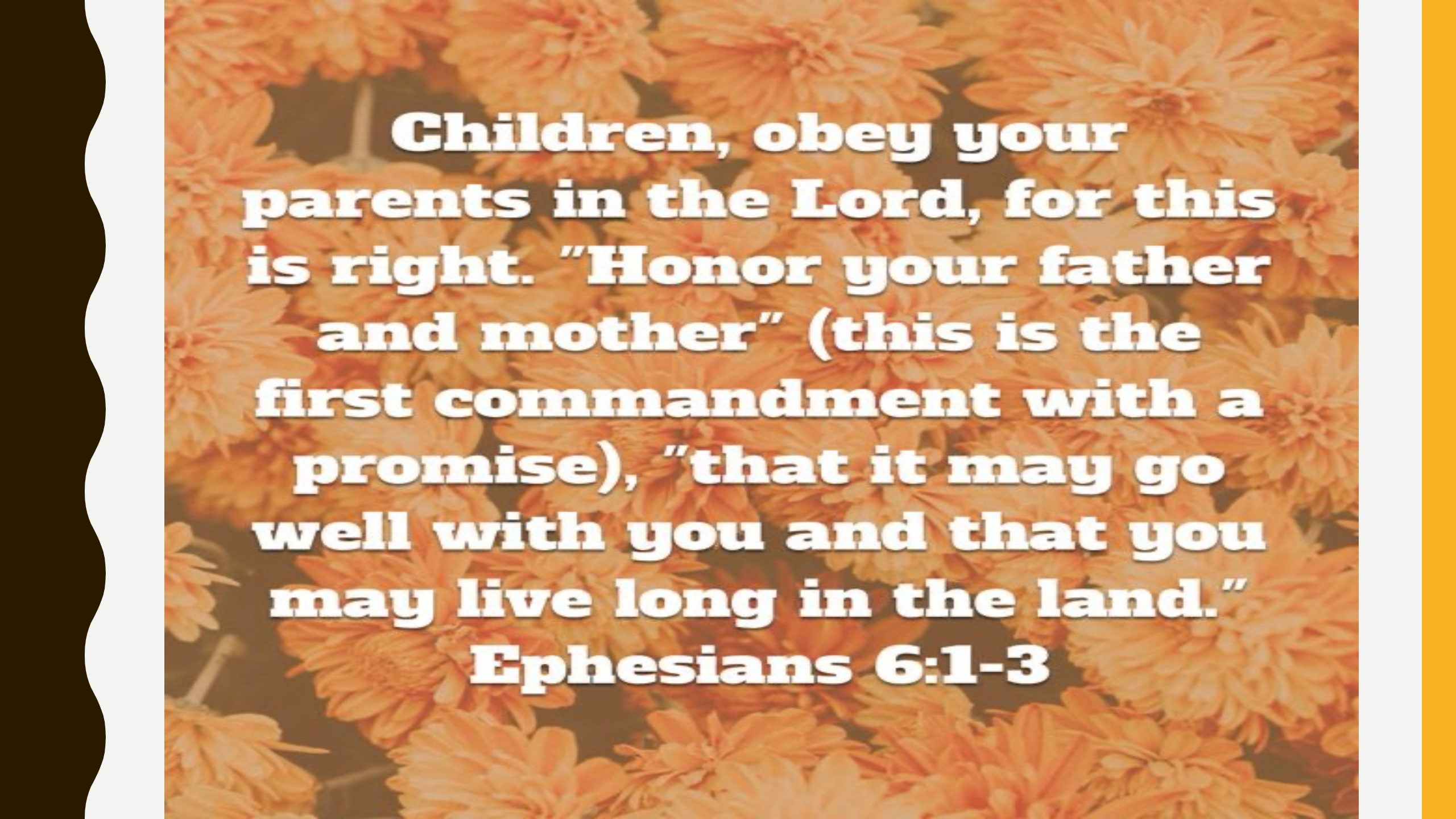
DEUTERONOMY 6:3-12

JOSHUA 1:1-9

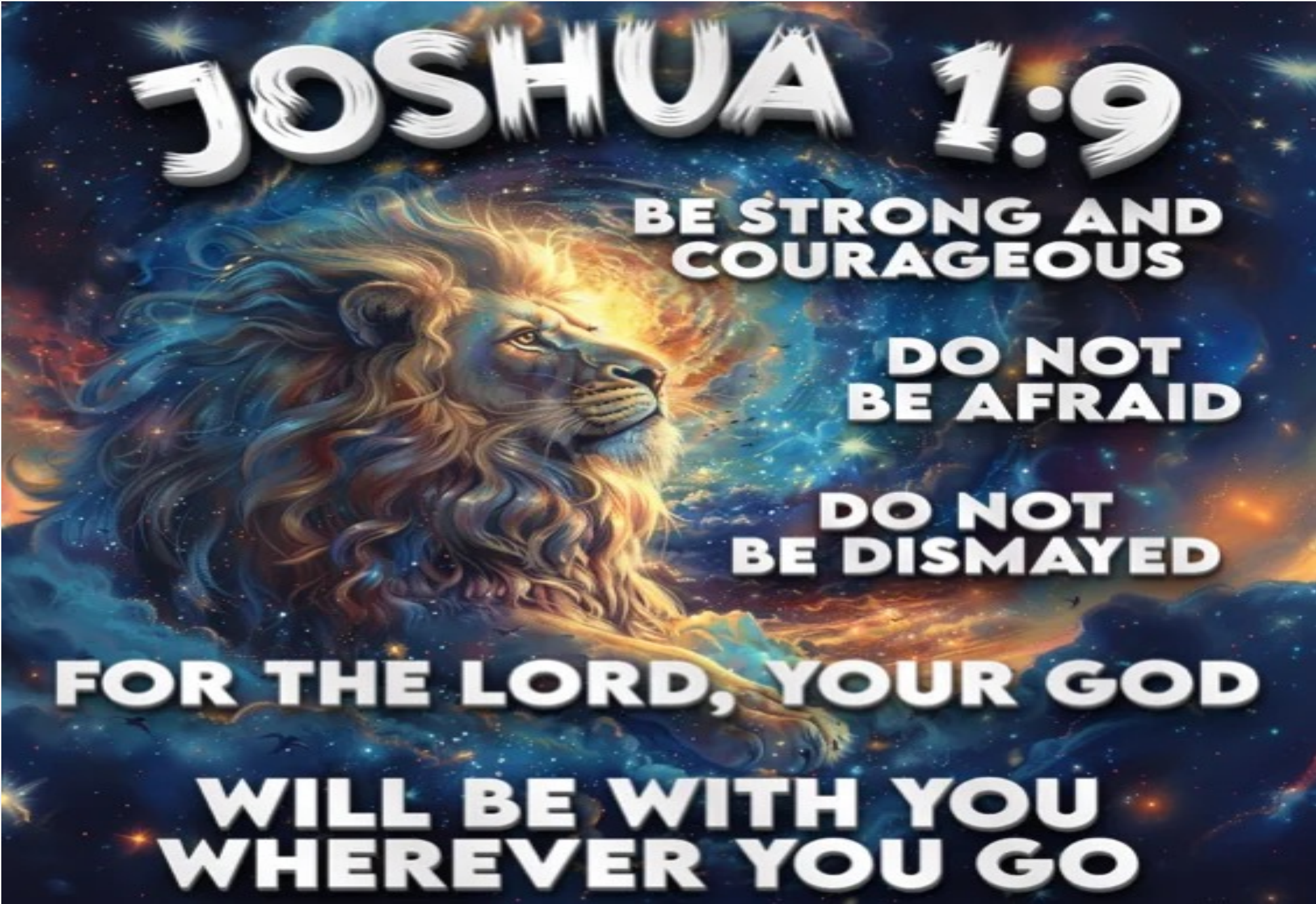
