I personally have always loved this story. For me, the big takeaway, the thing I always remember, is that you need an outside perspective. That sometimes we need someone to shout at us to try something different.

We can get really wrapped up in the way we do things. Maybe it's the way we have always done things and it always worked in the past. Maybe it's the first way that came to mind, so let's just go with it. Or maybe, we really don't know what we're doing, so we are kind of just flailing and hoping it's all going to work out.

I know I've been in every one of those positions before. Just ask Rita! My vision can get very narrowed when I'm working to the point, I fail to realize that what I'm doing isn't effective.

We need someone to shout, "Hey, try this!" When what we're doing isn't effective. When it seems like we're stuck spinning our wheels and are going nowhere. When it seems like we're not succeeding like we ought to. Then we need to have someone to offer up new advice.

That's why the Church needs each of us. Every one of us brings a new perspective to the Church Universal and Lakeville UMC. We need your ideas. We need your perspectives and experiences. No one else has them like you do, for no one else has lived your life.

We also need to be willing to take moments to listen to the Spirit. For it is easy for us to get so focused on what we're doing, we fail to hear the Spirit leading us elsewhere.
