1 Thessalonians 3:1-13 | October 26, 2025

- 1. What's the longest you like to be away from your phone before you get uncomfortable?
- 2. Read 1 Thessalonians chapter 3 and review the sermon outline. What stands out for you?
- 3. Paul was deeply concerned about the Thessalonians (see especially vs. 1 and vs. 5). Does this surprise you about Paul? How does this enhance your view of him?
- 4. What does Paul's concern for the Thessalonians show us about how we are designed to care for one another?
- 5. Look at vs. 3. Paul expected that trials would come. How might embracing that reality actually strengthen our hope instead of weakening it?
- 6. In verse 8, Paul says he "really lives" because of their faith. What does that reveal about the encouragement we receive from each other's perseverance?
- 7. Paul prays that God would "clear the way" for connection (vs. 11). What might God be inviting you to clear out of the way to deepen Christian friendships or community?
- 8. How have you seen God grow your faith, courage, or patience over time? How does recalling that growth renew your hope in the present?
