# Help Keep the Little Free Pantry Stocked


Thank you to all who support the pantry. During the coming cold months, the need will only increase with those who are hungry. Here are some items that could help:

- Water, small packets of water flavoring and flavoring drops
- Soup packets or cans
- Fruit (dried, canned or small cups)
- Snack items (crackers, granola bars, fruit bars, protein bars, etc.)
- Drinks (juice boxes, protein shakes, hot chocolate, instant coffee)
- Dried potato mixes and flavored rice packets
- Pasta and pasta mixes including those with protein, canned pasta
- Small packets of pancake mix, syrup
- Peanut butter
- Jelly
- Microwave popcorn, sunflower seeds
- Cereal (small boxes or packets including oatmeal and grits)
- Baby food (formula, small snack packets for toddlers, etc.)
- Diapers and wipes
- Oral hygiene items—toothbrush, toothpaste, dental floss, etc
- Personal hygiene products—toilet paper, soap, deodorant, lip balm, body lotion, combs, brushes, hair ties, etc.
- Feminine hygiene products
- Can openers—new or used in proper working order
- Wrapped utensil packets sent with food delivery that you may not need
- 16 oz. Insulated cups (used for making oatmeal and grits)
