Segment 2 Mission Development and Congregational Vitality Specialty Coaching

WHAT?

In this specialized Segment 2 Training, Coaches are educated in the context of Mission Development, Redevelopment, and Congregational Vitality, their commonalities, and differences. The 8 ICF Coaching Competencies will be explored and deepened through the lens of MD / CV Coaching.

Classes are 2 hours long, with class content taught during the first hour, and practicing coaching with volunteer MD / CV Coaching clients during the second hour.

WHO?

This Training is ideal for Coaches interested in growing their skills and accompanying missional leaders and congregations. Minimum requirement to attend this class is previous completion of a Segment 1 Coaching Class or equivalent.

CCE

16 credits of Continuing Coach Education (CCE) accredited by the International Coaching Federation (ICF)—12 credits for core competencies and four credits in resource development. This coaching curriculum seeks to support mission developers/redevelopers.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

At the end of this class, participants will

- Have a deepened and widened understanding of the 8 ICF Core Competencies
- Be able to competently connect the 8 ICF Coaching Competencies with the specific context of MD / CV Coaching.
- Be able to define the distinction between Mission Development, Redevelopment and Congregational Vitality, and navigate the specific needs, challenges, and opportunities of each area competently.
- Have reflected on the specific context of coaching people from diverse walks of life, with specific focus on minority and marginalized groups.
- Have practiced deep listening and powerful questioning in coaching conversations.
- Have explored the concept of Triangular Coaching with God's Holy Spirit as the third person in a coaching conversation in mind.
