

bounce buddies, scooter boards, and more.




- Bring socks for the bounce house and dry shoes to change out of wet winter boots when you arrive.

#### November Gift of Love — Loaves & Fishes

Loaves & Fishes mission is to provide nutritious meals to people who are hungry across Minnesota in an atmosphere of hospitality at site locations where the need is greatest and to develop joint ventures/partnerships with like-minded organizations assisting guests with additional basic needs key to becoming self-sufficient. We feed, out of our church kitchen, Monday-Friday, about 550 meals a week. These meals are served nightly from 5-6pm, prepared by volunteers from around the cities and served to-go for anyone who needs one.
