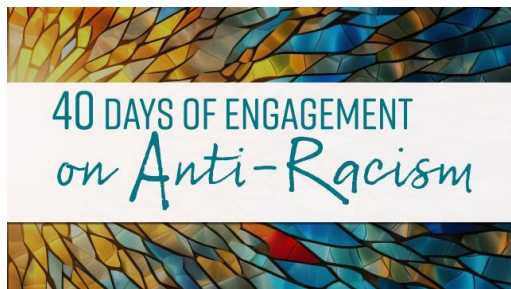


DROP THE GLOVES AND SOCK IT TO ME

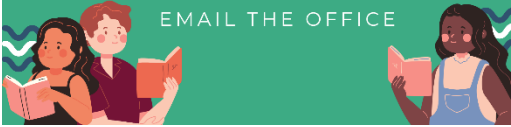
