Peace, Power, And Purpose Philippians 4:10-14

Paul tells the people he can be content in whatever situation he is in, and we have discovered that this is not a natural lesson, but a spiritual one. To have peace is not the absence of problems. It is the presence of God in the problem.

Paul says don't be anxious about anything, but in every situation with prayer, petition, and thanksgiving make your request to God. His word is alive, it still works miracles, and he will sustain you.

Wherever you need power, surrender it to him. It may be your home, body, or your faith walk. It may be your spouse, children or whoever, but give it to God who is able to do exceeding above any thing that you could ask or think.

There may be periods of darkness, but the sun will shine through. Don't let your problems or concerns stop you from praising God.

Paul's secret was not about struggle, it's how you handle it when you are going through trials and tribulations. When you give it to God you find peace and contentment in every situation. You find power, strength, purpose, and meaning in the midst of hardship.

God has to be the center of your life. Every act of love fulfills God's purpose. You can show God's love when you give to those in need.

Make a declaration that you can do all things through Christ who strengthens you. He is the prince of peace, and he is the purpose. In him you can find confidence and contentment in all things.
