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### Sunday School

This week children will be studying Lesson #8- Moses Leads the Escape. The Big Picture - God helps us do what's right, even when it's hard.  
Big Picture Verse- "Teach me knowledge and good judgement, for I believe in your commands" Psalm 119:66

Sometimes you might think that it's just too hard for a kid to do what God wants or that God only cares about the lives of grownups like parents, teachers or coaches, but God wants everyone to do what's right. Ask God to show you what's right. And ask Him to help you do it. He will help you do it. He'll even give you family and friends who will make it easier- just like He did for Moses.

Follow along at home- Discussion Questions-

1. What are some things kids your age do to love and obey God?  
(Be patient. Help an older neighbor.)
2. How might God help someone your age do what's right?  
(Give courage. Help the person think of a right action.)
3. Moses did what was right, even when it was hard. What are ways we can learn how to do what is right?

(Ask God for help. Follow example of other Christians.)
