"If you can LICK it or STICK it, we can use it!" This is the motto of the Shell Point Retirement Community located in Fort Myers, Florida where the stamp ministry began in 1971. I have mailed about two boxes of trimmed stamps to Shell Point every year since I took it over in 1997. Shell Point volunteers then prepare the stamps for buyers.

Since the ministry began in 1971, the sale of these stamps provided more than 50 Sunday School lesson series published for a Spanish language curriculum used in Latin America, Spain, and the USA.



Upon Shell Point's receipt of my recent box of cancelled stamps, I was informed \$20,000 was generated since June of this year alone.


