Text: **Luke 18:15-30**

Key ideas from the sermon:

1. No one is good except God alone.
2. The only way anyone can be received by God is to come to him like a child, without status or self glory.
3. For the rich man his god was his wealth - Jesus said to him, give your wealth away to the poor and come follow me. For us the call is the same, lay down for the good of others whatever it is that is more important to you than God, give it away, and come and follow Jesus.

Bible Study: The Swedish Method [Luke 18:15-30]

1. Begin by praying, asking God to speak through His Word
2. Read the Bible passage aloud, being careful to read slowly
3. Go back over the passage (allow about 10 minutes of silence), being on the lookout for, and making notes on the following four things:



Light bulb: This should be something that 'shine' from the passage - whatever impacts most, or draws attention.
