Special Need for young Pablo Araya

Dear Brethren,

I'm writing on behalf of our dear brother Danny Araya, missionary in Costa Rica, whose son Pablo is soon to undergo a bone marrow transplant. This has been such a complicated, drawn-out process, but the final tests are being done to get Pablo ready for his transplant surgery. The following is an explanation of the process.

Pablo will be in the hospital for one month. They will prepare him, treat him with chemotherapy to burn out the affected bone marrow, perform the transplant and keep him isolated. Visits from the family will be limited to only one hour a day with much caution. He will be in a room by himself and surrounded by doctors and nurses watching over him. This is a very, very delicate procedure. Any minute thing that goes wrong could produce disastrous results. They are taking every precaution for the completion of the transplant and the releasing of Pablo to return home. After the transplant procedure, he will return home and be in isolation for three months. Since Dani and his family moved into their father's house (next door) to help his mother after the passing of his father, his unoccupied house will be ideal for taking care of Pablo. Danny's wife Cindy will be with Pablo in the house attending to his every need, while constantly disinfecting his bedroom, the bathroom, etc. He can leave his bedroom only to use the restroom and then return. The house must be specially conditioned. Things must be repaired, the ceiling of the living room redone, the inside part of the house painted with special paint that absorbs humidity so as not to adversely affect Pablo, the windows sealed, etc. There can be no dust or any possible source of bacteria which could cause infection. This is so when Pablo leaves the hospital to come home, the house will be ready and he can recuperate without complications, since his body's immune system will be practically defenseless. This is a very complicated situation, with much work involved in getting things ready and making sure every precaution is taken to ensure Pablo's complete recovery. But Bro. Danny and family will do whatever is necessary for their beloved Pablo. His 17-year-old sister Sophia is ready to do her part in being the donor. She is trusting the Lord and willing to help her brother Pablo with whatever it takes.

From now till the time Pablo is released to come home, the family will be busy in making the necessary adjustments to the house. Unfortunately, many expenses are involved in the process. Bro. Danny says he needs at least \$3000 to do the work. We are asking the Lord to provide the \$3000 to prevent the family from having to ask for a loan and be under that financial burden. If you know Bro. Danny or are a supporting church, you made be led by the Lord to help with this need. Please let me know if you would like to help. In hospital for one month, will prepare him, give him chemo treatment, will be isolated, only certain times one hour at a time, sleep by himself, surrounded by doctors and nurses, very, very delicate process, any minute thing to go wrong would produce terrible results. Taking every precaution after the transplant when he is at home. After a month in the hospital, he will go home and be in isolation for three months. Since Dani moved into his father's house to help his mother, this left his house open for this specific time. Cindy will be with Pablo, helping him, and constantly disinfecting the bathroom, his bedroom, etc. He can't leave the bedroom, only to go to the bathroom, then return. The house must be especially conditioned. Things must be repaired, the ceiling of the living room, paint the house with a special paint that absorbs the humidity so as not to affect Pablo, seal up the windows, and other things. So, when he comes home, all will be ready for him. So, he can recuperate without complications, because his immune system will be totally defenseless. No dust, no possible bacteria to cause infections, etc. It's very complicated and there is a lot of work, but we will make sure we do all we can to provide a safe environment for Pablo. We have one month to do all this. Pray for \$3000 needed for all that must be done: paint the house, do the ceiling, the bathrooms, etc. to have all the safety measures set up and ready for when Pablo returns from the hospital.
