If you purchased and were unhappy with your Picture Package, please send your Picture Package to school with your student on Retake Day. Your Retake Picture Package will be produced and shipped to the school four weeks after Retake Day. Please note, if your child is photographed on the original and Retake Picture Days, the Retake picture will replace the

original picture in certain products, like the yearbook.

Students who were absent for Picture Day should come to school prepared to have their picture taken. To avoid shipping fees, pre-orders need to be placed by picture day.

The principle of acceptable dress for a Christian school setting will be in effect for pictures. What does this mean?

- All clothing is to fit properly, have finished hems, and be neat, clean, and worn as designed.
- Students are prohibited from wearing any clothing, jewelry, or accessories bearing words and/or pictures associated with liquor, drugs, foul language, satanic groups, racism, or any other anti-Christian subject matter.
- Students may wear jeans
- · Girls may wear dresses that have designs and or patterns. Dresses should not have spaghetti straps.
- · Girls should not wear leggings unless they are worn underneath a skirt or dress.
- Shirts or tops with designs or patterns may be worn for picture day
- Tennis shoes and dress shoes with closed toes and backs are permissible styles.
- Shorts, skirts, skorts, and dresses should be of appropriate length. They must be, at the minimum, as long as a student's fingertips when the arms are relaxed at the side with fingers extended straight down.







Wave 'Em If You Have 'Em is a prelude to Operation Bugle Boy's Veterans Appreciation Night, which is a free event for military veterans and their guests at the St. Martins Knights of Columbus Hall. Tickets are required for the event, which includes camaraderie, remembrance, and a Thanksgiving-style dinner. While all military veterans and Armed Forces members are honored at Veterans Appreciation Night, there is a special emphasis this year on recognizing veterans who served during the Vietnam War.

Honorary Guests for the evening will be selected local military veterans who served during this critical time in our nation's history. These Vietnam War veterans and their guests will ride aboard a trolley donated by The Trolley Company, accompanied by a motorcade, from Candlewood Suites on Amazonas Drive in western Jefferson City to the Veterans Appreciation Night event at the St. Martins Knights of Columbus Hall.


