Youth Recap

It's been a great month together on Wednesday nights! Each week, we spend the first hour connecting through games, activities, and hanging out, and then we open the Bible to learn what God's Word has to say to us. This fall, we've been in a series called "Rescue – How Jesus Saves," exploring how God steps in to save His people. Our theme verse has been Colossians 1:13: "For He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness..."

The idea we've been focusing on is this: "Salvation is God rescuing you from whatever is destroying you." We've looked at Bible stories where Jesus did exactly that—saving a wedding, healing an outcast, rescuing a woman from condemnation, freeing a boy from oppression, and pulling Peter from the water.

All of these point to the greatest rescue of all: Jesus saving us from sin through His death and resurrection. Stories we've looked at include:

Exodus 14 – God rescuing Israel through the Red Sea

John 2:1-11 – Jesus turning water into wine, showing His power to transform

Mark 1:40-45 – Jesus healing a man with leprosy, revealing His compassion and authority

John 8:1-11 – Jesus rescuing a woman from condemnation

Mark 9:14-29 – Jesus rescuing a boy from an unclean spirit

Matthew 14:22-33 – Jesus rescuing Peter as he walks on the water

Luke 22-24 – Jesus' death and resurrection, the ultimate rescue

The goal has been to see that Jesus saves, and to ask: "What do you need Jesus to save you from?"
