We are now in November, the month of Thanksgiving, but you wouldn't know it for all the advertising going on. Save for a few pilgrimthemed paper goods, piles of turkeys in the freezer case and stacks of stuffing mix and cream of mushroom soup in the grocery aisles, there isn't a lot of evidence that the holiday of gratitude is approaching for all the shelf space devoted to Halloween and Christmas.

Not that we need it, of course. Families and friends will be gathering around tables ladened with favorite foods and lots of people will be journeying "over the river and through the woods" to arrive at the places where Thanksgiving is most fondly celebrated. You don't need a month of TV shows or mass marketing to be thankful. But a little reminder doesn't hurt, now and then.

I got one of those reminders, just today. A woman came to church asking to speak with me. As she entered my office she said, "You probably don't remember me." I recognized her face but had long forgotten her name. As soon as she told me what it was, the memories began to return.

It was seven years ago we met, about this time of year or a bit later. I remember that the choir was rehearsing in the sanctuary and it was already dark outside, which probably made the light beaming from the windows even more noticeable. She remembers that hearing the singing gave her the courage to walk through the open doors.

Back then she arrived with the grime of the streets on her clothes. She stood in God's house homeless. Fleeing an abusive man. Apart from her children. Estranged from her family. We sat down in the library. I got her something warm to drink. I listened to her story and prayed with her. That's all she wanted. I pressed a gift card into her hand and bid her godspeed, never imagining we'd ever speak again.

But we did, a couple hours ago. She's now adequately housed, working three jobs and the court today granted her custody of three of her five children. That's why she returned. She said Trinity's kindness on that horrible day seven years ago "awakened" her to God's love for her and the hope God's love gives. She came simply to say thanks.

Wow. I was reminded that the smallest expressions of God's love can have the biggest impacts and that, no matter what, reasons to be grateful are all around us.

In this season of thanksgiving, I give thanks for this young woman, whose gratitude surprised and enlivened my faith. I give thanks that Trinity's lights were on and doors were open when she desperately needed a place to feel welcomed. I give thanks for all of you, without whom the gospel could not live in this place as powerfully as it did seven years ago. As it still does. Happy Thanksgiving, Gemma. Happy Thanksgiving to us all!

our Community Thanksgiving! Thank you all for your support!


