# 1 Thessalonians 3:8 (NKJV)

<sup>8</sup> For now we live, if you stand fast in the Lord. **to stand (maintain)** v. — to hold one's ground; maintain a position; be steadfast or upright.

## 1 Corinthians 16:13 (NKJV)

<sup>13</sup> Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong.

### Galatians 5:1 (NKJV)

**5** Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.

## Philippians 1:27 (NKJV)

<sup>27</sup> Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel,
