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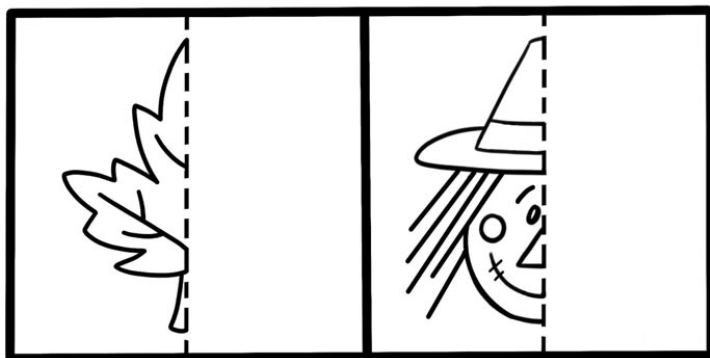
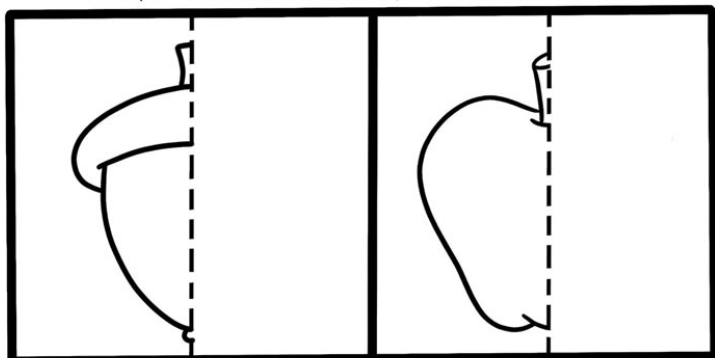
Pumpkin Maze

Can you make it through the maze?



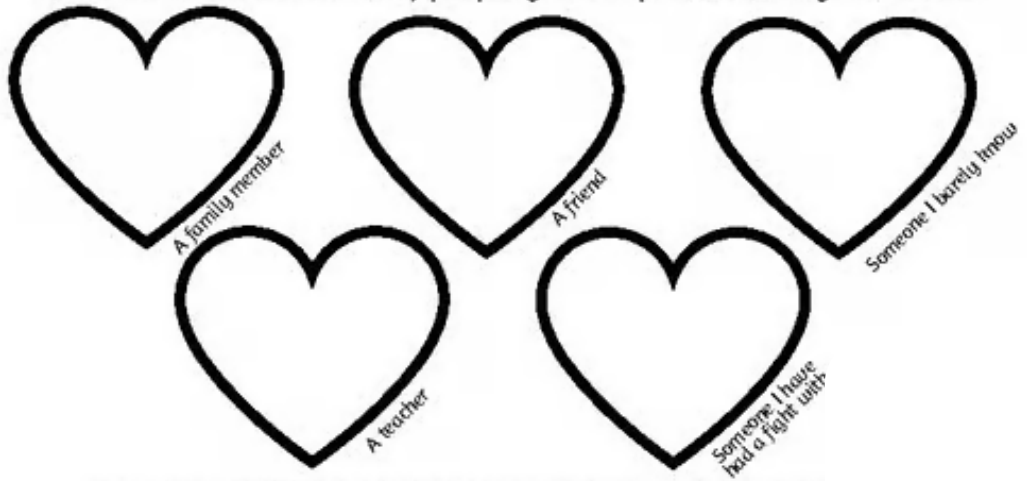
