Part 4: PATIENCE

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control Galatians 5:22-23 NASB

PATIENCE: macrothumia (macro - "long" thumos - "temper") LONG TEMPER

WE NEED THE HOLY SPIRIT'S PATIENCE IN THREE MAIN AREAS:

1. Patience with difficult people.

Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Ephesians 4:2 NIV

"Forbearance is the quality of self-restraint in the face of provocation. It does not quickly retaliate or punish."

"Holy Spirit-empowered patience is the patience of someone who is ferociously wronged, terribly sinned against, and who has the reason, the right, the ability, the opportunity and the power to avenge the wrong, but doesn't do it."

2. Patience in <u>difficult</u> circumstances.

"We must go through many hardships to enter the kingdom of God." Acts 14:22 My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, ³ knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. ⁴ But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

James 1:2-4 NKJV

Patience under trial is our pathway to <u>maturity</u>.

We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance. ⁴ And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation. ⁵ And this hope will not lead to disappointment. Romans 5:3-5 NLT

The only way to develop endurance is to endure. The only way to cultivate perseverance is to persevere.

3. Patience while <u>waiting for</u> prayers and promises to be fulfilled.

You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised. Hebrews 10:36 NIV

We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.

Hebrews 6:12 NIV
