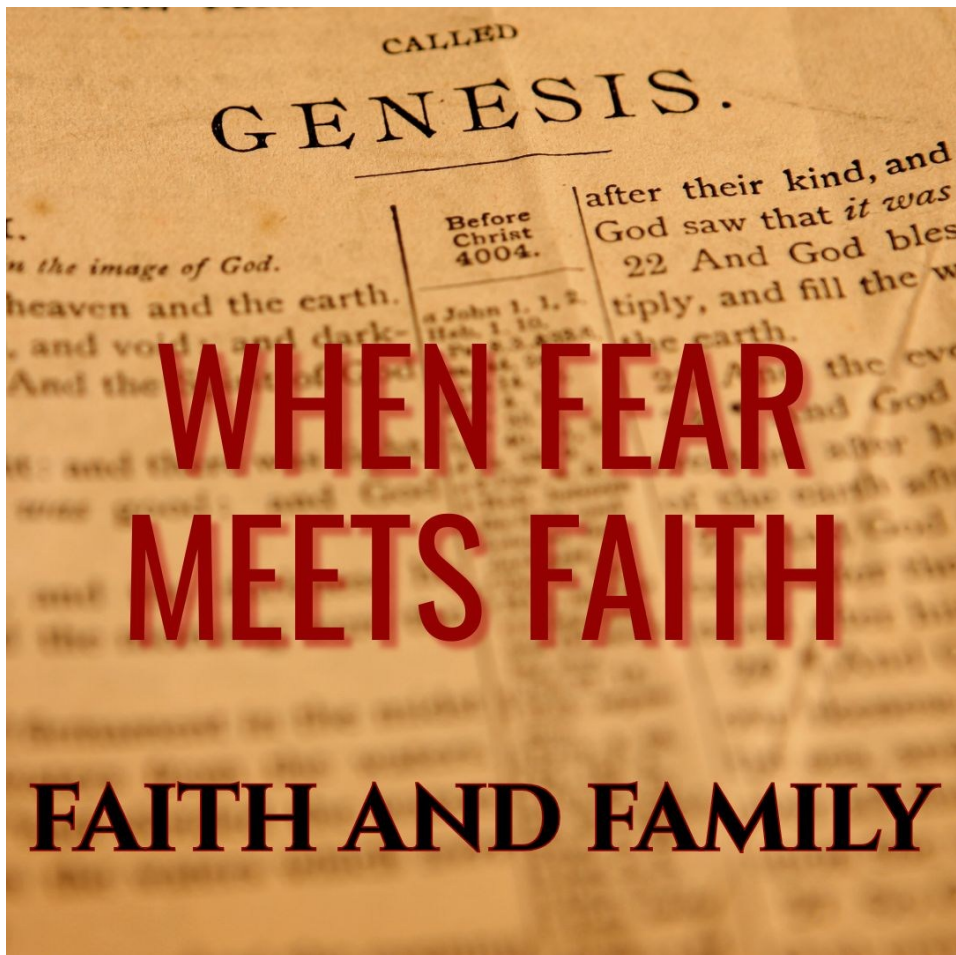

## SERMON

## “FAITH AND FAMILY: WHEN FEAR MEETS FAITH”

*Jacob went on his way, and the angels of God met him. <sup>2</sup>And when Jacob saw them he said, “This is God's camp!” So he called the name of that place Mahanaim. <sup>3</sup>And Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his brother in the land of Seir, the country of Edom, <sup>4</sup>instructing them, “Thus you shall say to my lord Esau: Thus says your servant Jacob, ‘I have sojourned with Laban and stayed until now. <sup>5</sup>I have oxen, donkeys, flocks, male servants, and female servants. I have sent to tell my lord, in order that I may find favor in your sight.’” (Genesis 32:1-5)*

### 1. EVEN IN FEAR, GOD’S \_\_\_\_\_ COMES FIRST.

*The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?*

*The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?*

*(Psalm 27:1)*

*And the messengers returned to Jacob, saying, “We came to your brother Esau, and he is coming to meet you, and there are four hundred men with him.” <sup>7</sup>Then Jacob was greatly afraid and distressed...*

*(Genesis 32:6-7)*

*And Jacob said, “O God of my father Abraham and God of my father Isaac, O Lord who said to me, ‘Return to your country and to your kindred, that I may do you good,’ <sup>10</sup>I am not worthy of the least of all the deeds of steadfast love and all the faithfulness that you have shown to your servant, for with only my staff I crossed this Jordan, and now I have become two camps. <sup>11</sup>Please deliver me from the hand of my brother, from the hand of Esau, for I fear him, that he may come and attack me, the mothers with the children. <sup>12</sup>But you said, ‘I will surely do you good, and make your offspring as the sand of the sea, which cannot be numbered for multitude.’”*

*(Genesis 32:9-12)*

To Your heart to Your heart

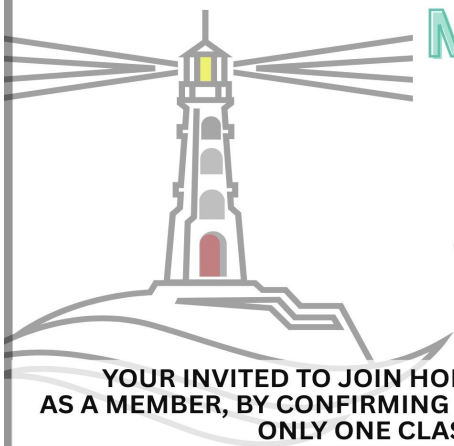
