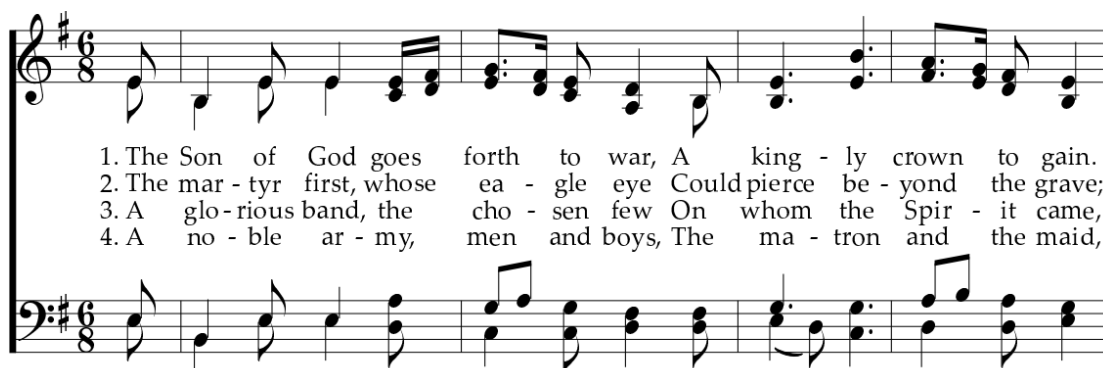

Song of The Month

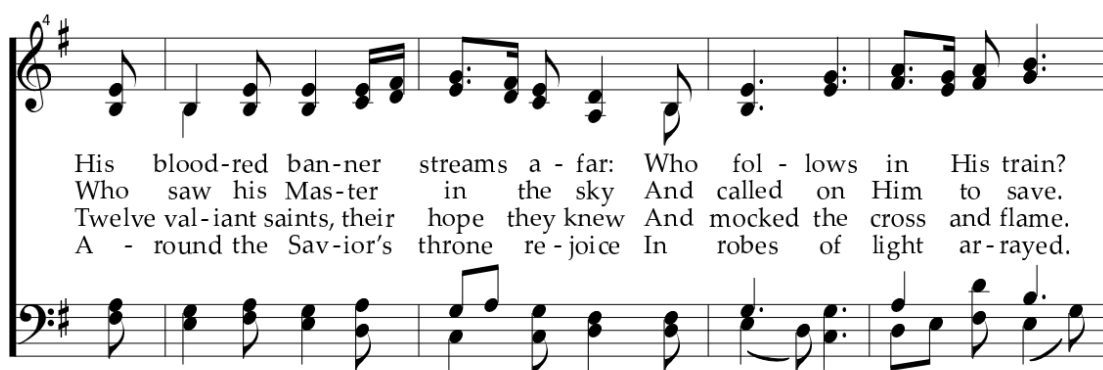
This month's song is The Son of God Goes Forth to War. We will be learning to sing this in parts on a Sunday morning soon! You can hear the tune on YouTube here:

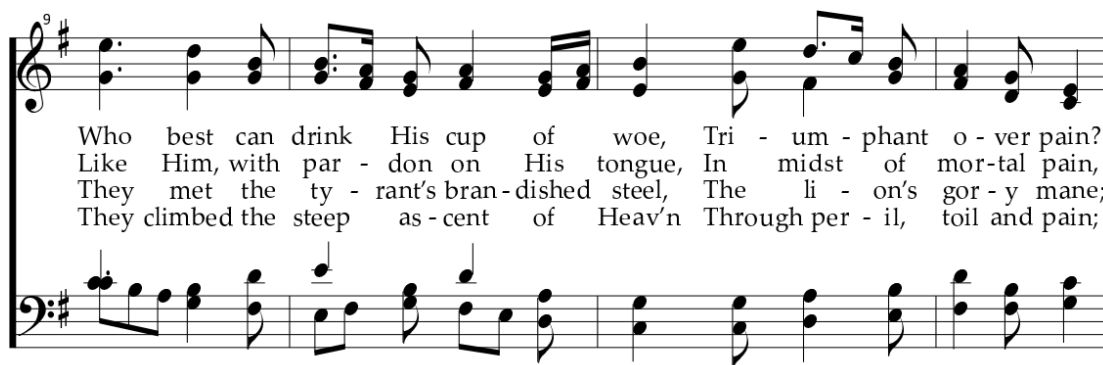
The Son of God Goes Forth to War



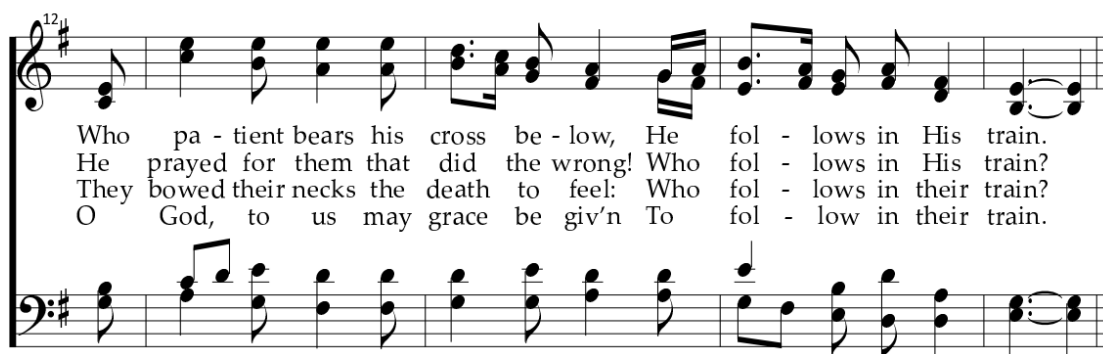
1. The Son of God goes forth to war, A king - ly crown to gain.
