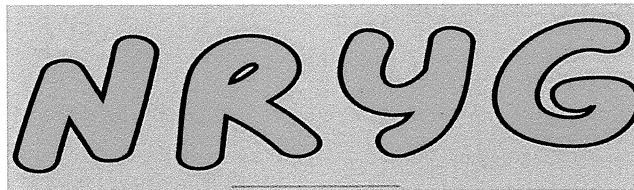

Julie Gallardo - former member, has been diagnosed with cancer. She is home and in pain and requests our prayers.

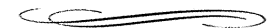
Delores Reazola - Has kidney failure and is in the process of scheduling a kidney transplant.
