However, focussing on discipleship for the retreat was set up to kick us off on a focus of discipleship for the coming year. We're still working on what that will look like, but now you have a glimpse of what is coming. The three Bible studies will continue, as well as the Saturday morning group. And, we plan to keep building spaces where men can gather and grow in maturity in Christ.

RICK REMPEL - MISSIONS LEAD '25

As a church we are supporting 17 full-time missionaries serving both overseas and in Canada. We are thankful to each one who have given so that we can serve and support these missionaries in the work that they do. This past year has been a difficult time for several of our missionaries and we tried to be there for them and to support them as we could, both through extra support as they transitioned to another mission agency and as we tried to connect with each one as they came through this area, to hear from them and pray for them as they journeyed through this difficult time.

Short Term Opportunites

This year we were able to support the Mexico missions trip lead by Pastor Paris and Pastor Josh along with some of our youth who also went along. We also had 2 other youth whom we supported, one to Colombia with the PCA group and another one who went to Peru with their school.

Budget

We are so thankful for the generosity of the Mount Olive church, it is such a huge blessing both to us as a committee and, I am sure to those that we are able to support. We again saw an increase in our budget to \$112,000 to cover the support for the missionaries. Regarding donations, we were short about \$11,000 but because we didn't spend all of the allocated funds we ended up with only a \$8,500 short fall.

Missions Committee

Thanks goes to all the members of the committee and all the work that they put in, from all the meetings to the Annual Global Focus weekend. The current members of the committee are Rick & Tracey Rempel, David Crossley, Jennifer Marples, Rob & Deb MacDonald and Mike Schmidt. This past year we met 13 times as a committee and we had the opportunity to meet with 7 of our missionaries when they were here in town.

Annual Global Focus

For the annual global focus in 2024 we had David Wright come and share with us on theme of Many Roles -One Mission. For the project we raise about \$14,000 to go towards drilling the well for the Theissen's in Mongolia, and also a Focus on the Family, "Odyssey-like" project that the Sorrells are working on for the First Nations peoples here in Canada. In the Sunday School classes the Braim kids connected with our kids to learn about living overseas. This year the youth connected with the Penner's to have a more meaningful and intentional connection with a missionary.



Finance - Year in Review

This is my fourth year in the position of helping with finance. As you are aware, we have changed our budget year to go from July 1 to June 30. So, I want to give a recap of our June year end as well as a bit of a glimpse of where we are sitting in our 2025-2026 year to date.

For the first time I have been able to say we ended at 98% of our budgeted amount for our general fund. Some of our other budget lines had a little bigger difference, but when we look at our total year end numbers, we ended with a \$38,318.55 surplus (104%)!!! With all the ministry taking place in our church, it has been a truly amazing year. Thank you so much for your generosity. It has been exciting to me to see that God is moving in so many ways.

Money is just one of the means to help fulfill what God has invited us to participate in. Over this last year, God has continued to multiply our tithes. As we continue to watch for the fingerprints of God in our community, I pray He will continue to reveal where He wants us to move.



For our current year-to-date, we are sitting at 97% for our general fund giving and at 102% for our mission's fund. That is crazy amazing!

I want to challenge you to continue being faithful in giving back to God. No strings, no excuses, open handed and completely trusting Him to provide. You will not be disappointed. He is a good dad.

A huge thank you to Sherryl and all the work she does with the financials. It is a big task, and she does it with joy. There are also several others behind the scenes that need to be commended for all their work. Make sure you thank them when you get a chance. Karen Weigum, Chris Griesbach, Randy Schartner and Pastor Paris help keep everyone accountable and error free, and Karen W. does all the tax receipting. Now that is a task I don't envy. Also, to the board who puts in multiple hours of their time. We appreciate you all!
