¹⁰ For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Psalms 100:3 (NKJV)

³ Know that the LORD, He *is* God;
It is He *who* has made us, and not we ourselves;
We are His people and the sheep of His pasture.

Hebrews 3:4 (NKJV)

⁴ For every house is built by someone, but He who built all things *is* God.

Isaiah 29:23 (NKJV)

²³ But when he sees his children, The work of My hands, in his midst,
They will hallow My name, And hallow the Holy One of Jacob,

Psalms 139:14 (NKJV)

¹⁹ But when they deliver you up, do not worry about how or what you should speak. For it will be given to you in that hour what you should speak;

²⁰ But indeed, O man, who are you to reply against God? Will the thing formed say to him who formed *it*, “Why have you made me like this?” ²¹ Does not the potter have power over the clay, from the same lump to make one vessel for honor and another for dishonor?

Isaiah 10:15 (NKJV)

²² With you also I will break in pieces man and woman;

You shall condemn.
