Part 5: Kindness/Goodness

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, <u>kindness</u>, <u>goodness</u>, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. Galatians 5:22-23 NASB

You can't <u>learn</u> fruit. Fruit is the <u>byproduct</u> of who we are.

TWO ASPECTS OF KINDNESS:

An Inner <u>Disposition</u>

"Kindness is an inner disposition which delights in cheerfully advancing the happiness of others and in meeting their needs, fulfilling their wishes, and removing their distresses."

An Outward <u>Demonstration</u>

"Kindness is goodness in action. It's an expression of love that does something to bless and benefit others." "Kindness is the medium through which the love of God becomes tangible through believers."

THE KINDNESS OF GOD

He has shown <u>kindness</u> by giving you rain from heaven and crops in their seasons; he provides you with plenty of food and fills your hearts with joy."

Acts 14:17

And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, 7 in order that in the coming ages he might show the incomparable riches of his grace, expressed in his kindness to us in Christ Jesus. Ephesians 2:6-7

Or do you show contempt for the riches of his kindness, forbearance and patience, not realizing that God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance? Romans 2:4

It's God's kindness that ultimately wins our heart and draws us toward himself.

David asked, "Is there anyone still left of the house of Saul to whom I can show kindness for Jonathan's sake?" 2 Samuel 9:1

"Don't be afraid," David said to him, "for I will surely show you kindness for the sake of your father Jonathan. I will restore to you all the land that belonged to your grandfather Saul, and you will always eat at my table." 8 Mephibosheth bowed down and said, "What is your servant, that you should notice a dead dog like me?" (2 Samuel 9:7-8)

And <u>be kind</u> to one another, <u>tenderhearted</u>, <u>forgiving</u> one another, even as God in Christ forgave you. Ephesians 4:32 NKJV

Kindness is a <u>choice</u>.

Kindness is a matter of the heart.

Kindness flows from a forgiving heart.

So, as the Holy Spirit says: "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your heart as you did in the rebellion, during the time of testing in the wilderness...Hebrews 3:7-8
