## Japan Report

Bekah and I had a very successful ministry trip! We visited 4 prefectures and connected with old contacts and also met many new ones! Our goal was to encourage the Churches, Pastors and missionaries there. We both felt that we accomplished that to the best out our ability through the power of the Holy Spirit.

### Tokyo

In Tokyo we visited with Pastor Masa and his wife of Awakening Tokyo Church. We heard his story and what the Lord has been doing. I asked how I could help in the future and he asked me to bring teams with me to help him in doing street ministry. They often do street ministry where they preach the gospel and sing, then they lay hands on the sick and see them healed. I also happened to visit with an American Pastor who was visiting from Honk Kong where he pastors. We then visited Pastor Danzo at the United Church of Christ. He was shocked when I dropped into his church and asked me to pray for him and his church twice when I was there. It was clear he was blessed by our visit. Lastly Bekah and I took out for supper a friend of ours that we have been encouraging and mentoring in the last 2 years.

### Yamanashi

In Yamanashi we visited with a missionary there who went to Bible college with me years ago. We then met with the Pastor in Kofu. His church graciously put us up in a hotel for one night there. The next day I preached and ministered in their church. We saw Jesus heal a lady there of extreme shoulder pain. She was absolutely shocked!

## Osaka

We spent a whole day in the poorest and highest crime neighbourhood. The infamous Japanese mafia, Yakuza runs that area as a part of their territory. We went there to help out and see what the Lord is doing there. There is a church called “Roses Church” that takes place each Wednesday for about 7 hours in the park. There amongst the homeless the Church does worship and shares the gospel with the locals. Bekah and I shared Christ with a few key people that we talked to for hours. We saw the Holy Spirit working on peoples hearts! Afterwards we attend a Bible study that turned into a spontaneous testimony time. After 3 hours, I shared my testimony and then Bekah and I left as we hadn't had supper and it was already night. On our way back we walked past some Yakuza mafia guys sitting by the park entrance. After we passed by them, they followed us. We later found out they most likely followed us to make sure we got out safely and so they protected us from possible gangs or muggings.

One another day we spent with a missionary we met at Roses Church. He and his wife are Kiwi. We spent time at their house visiting and praying, then he took us out for sushi and later showed us around. That was a blessed time. Lastly we had coffee with another pastor in Osaka who does a similar thing that Awakening Tokyo does for street ministry.

## Ishikawa

In our last prefecture we stayed with Michael and Chiiko Geunter (We call Japanese mom and dad). I preached and ministered at their church. The Lord moved powerfully there! I was then asked to meet a rice farmer (Chiiko's brother in law). I've known him since I first came in 2018. It was cool that he wanted to see me. We went and he showed us how to plant rice and then we went to his office where we prayed and again God moved! Lastly in Ishikawa we did a long prayer walk and prayed for 6 churches that we walked up to and played hands on the buildings!

Overall it was very successful. I am staying in contact with these new connections that I made! I will be going back next year. I was asked to officiate a wedding there and will also do ministry there again.

## Ontario

Lastly before I went to Japan, my dad and I traveled to Fort Francis where I spoke at New Beginnings Church. I was one of the speakers at a Missions fest on Saturday and Sunday. Sunday evening I was the closing speaker and the Holy Spirit moved powerfully!! The service went on for about 5 hours as many were being filled and touch by God. It was a real blessing for me as I saw God move powerfully! There was a number of times where the Lord gave me clear visions about someone when I was praying for them. I stepped out in faith and shared what the Lord gave me, I would then ask if that made sense and if possibly I was out to lunch. It was so cool to see the incredible confirmations! Glory to God! I must say, some of the things were so specific where I thought “God, are you sure? I'm going to look crazy if I'm wrong”. It was spot on! I kept telling people “This just shows that Jesus knows everything about you, things that others wouldn't know!” The cool thing is that I had nothing to do with it, it's all because of Jesus! He deserves all the glory!
