



#### **What Truly Satisfies**

As we move fully into November, I encourage you to continue following the reading plan for The Bible Year, which extends through the end of December (you can access those readings here). While we follow this plan, our worship this Sunday will take a slight detour to reflect on the season we are in: stewardship.

I know what you're thinking—you're scrolling down to get to the rest of the newsletter. Please pause for just a moment, because stewardship is more than a task on a to-do list; it is crucial to living a fulfilled life. The word "stewardship" literally means "to take care of something," and it begins with taking care of ourselves in the ways that matter most. Perhaps if we called these Sundays "reflections on self-care", we might all feel a little lighter! Our faith, and God's wisdom expressed through Scripture, has so much to offer on the journey to a meaningful, abundant life. Why would we not want to participate in that offering?

This Sunday, we turn to the prophet Isaiah for guidance. Isaiah 55:1–2a reads:

"Why do you spend your money for that which is not bread, and your labor for that which does not satisfy? Listen carefully to me, and eat what is good, and delight yourselves in rich food."

Through these words, God calls to a weary people—then and now—who have spent their energy chasing things that can never truly satisfy. Our culture tells us that happiness can be bought, that success comes from accumulation, and that contentment depends on possessions. But God offers something radically different: an invitation to come, eat, and delight in what truly satisfies.

At Denver UMC, we understand stewardship not as obligation, but as trust. When we give, when we share, when we invest in God's work through our church, we are making a

statement with our lives: "I believe there is enough."

As Walter Brueggemann reminds us, "the world runs on anxiety, but the gospel invites us into trust." Stewardship is our response to that invitation—a way of living in God's abundance rather than the world's scarcity.

May this season of stewardship be an opportunity for all of us to rediscover what truly satisfies: the goodness of God, the joy of generosity, and the blessing of belonging to a community shaped by grace.




