### Crisis

The main objective of the Crisis Ministry is to **provide** assistance to people who are in need while treating them with dignity and love.

Each person requesting assistance is given a confidential interview and information is verified. ELCM is not a maintenance agency but provides monetary assistance to clients in financial need according to set guidelines, and reviews their needs regularly.

#### Crisis offers aid through the following programs:

- + Christian literature
- + food and clothing
- + household items and furniture
- + baby items & nursery furniture
- + nursing home items
- + loan of home nursing care items
- + fans and heaters
- + back-to-school program
- + holiday baskets and meals
- + Angel Gift program
- + tax assistance

Crisis has also responded with disaster relief to areas that have experienced flooding and hurricanes and will continue to aid agencies that are in need.

### The Pantry

The Pantry is where food and personal hygiene items are stored to be used in filling food orders for Crisis clients.

#### The following food items are always needed:

canned meats

peanut butter

canned fruit

canned & dried beans

canned vegetables dry cereal/oatmeal

rice spaghetti

macaroni & cheese

sugar, oil & shortening

Cans or plastic, rather than glass containers, are preferred. Dry food items such as beans, rice and pasta should be in 1-pound packages. Smaller sizes of canned goods are preferred.

#### Additional household items needed:

dishwashing liquid laundry detergent bar soap toilet paper toothbrushes

shampoo deodorant

toothpaste

## Home Meals

The HOME MEALS Ministry provides well-balanced meals to individuals in the East Lincoln area who are homebound due to illness, disability, injury or advanced age. Physicians, home health services, family members, concerned neighbors and friends make referrals.

Hot meals are delivered at lunchtime five days a week (excluding holidays) by a team of volunteers. Delivery of a Home Meal also provides an opportunity to check on the welfare of the recipient at midday.

The Home Meals Delivery program receives no Federal funds. Recipients pay for the meals according to their ability to pay. Anyone who resides in the East Lincoln area who would benefit from this service should call the Home Meals Hotline at 704-483-9238.

### The Closet

Sales from The Closet, Fashion and Furniture are the main source of funding for ELCM. The Silent Auction is an added source of revenue where treasures are displayed, and bids recorded. Winners are notified on the auction closing date.

A wide variety of donations is accepted including clothing, household goods, baby items, toys, books, etc.

Volunteers are always needed to sort, tag and display donations. Special arrangements may be made for groups who would like to spend hours helping in The Closet.
