Sunday School Lesson Plan – Sunday, December 7, 2025

Here's a Sunday School Lesson Plan for young children (ages 4-8) using the Revised Common Lectionary readings for December 7, 2025 – Second Sunday of Advent (Year A) Bible Verses: Is 11:1-10; Ps 72:1-7, 18-19; Rom 15:4-13; Mt 3:1-12

Theme: "Preparing Our Hearts for Jesus"

Based on: Isaiah 11:1-10; Psalm 72:1-7, 18-19; Romans 15:4-13; Matthew 3:1-12



Lesson Overview

Lesson Title: Preparing the Way for Jesus

Theme: God is sending Jesus, the Prince of Peace. We can get our hearts ready for Him. **Big Idea:** God promised a Savior who will bring peace, love, and hope to everyone.

Lesson Focus for Kids: Advent is a time to get ready—not just by decorating or waiting, but by

being kind, loving, and listening to God.

Scripture Readings (Kid-Friendly Language)

• Isaiah 11:1–10:

"Out of a tree stump will grow a new branch! It will be full of life and bring hope. The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him—he will be wise, strong, and full of peace. Even wild animals will live together in peace when he comes."

• Psalm 72:1–7, 18–19:

"God's chosen King will be fair and kind. He will help people who are poor and bring peace that lasts forever."

• Romans 15:4–13:

"God gives us hope through His Word. Be happy together, and praise God with one heart!"

Matthew 3:1–12:

"John the Baptist told everyone, 'Get ready! The Lord is coming! Change your hearts and do what is right."



Welcome & Opening Prayer / Circle Time

Welcome:

Sit in a circle. Ask:

"What do you do to get ready for something special—like a birthday, a trip, or Christmas?" Let the children share. Explain that Advent means getting ready for Jesus' coming.

Opening Prayer:

"Dear God, thank You for loving us and sending Jesus. Help us to get our hearts ready for Him by being kind and loving this week. Amen."



Memory Verse

"Prepare the way for the Lord." – *Matthew 3:3*

Practice saying it with hand motions:

- "Prepare" (pretend to sweep)
- "the way" (point ahead)
- "for the Lord" (point up)




🔰 Bible Story Time

Story Summary (in simple language):

John the Baptist lived in the desert. He wore clothes made of camel hair and ate honey and bugs! He told people to stop doing wrong things and get ready because someone very special—Jesus was coming soon! John said Jesus would bring God's love and make everything new and good again.

Discussion Questions:

- Who was John the Baptist?
- What did he tell people to do?
- How can we get ready for Jesus? (Examples: being kind, saying sorry, helping others)



Craft Option 1: "Advent Path - Preparing the Way"

Supplies:

Paper, markers, glue, stickers, and strips of yellow paper (to be "path stones").

Instructions:

- 1. Draw a path leading to a heart with "Jesus" written inside.
- 2. On each "stone," children write or draw ways they can prepare their hearts (help Mom, share, pray, say sorry, etc.).
- 3. Glue the stones along the path.
- 4. Add sparkly stars or stickers around it.

Craft Option 2: John the Baptist Puppet

Supplies: Paper bag or craft stick, brown paper (for camel hair clothes), markers, yarn. Make John with wild hair and write "Prepare the Way!" on his robe.



Game: "Clear the Path!"

How to Play:

Make an obstacle course with chairs, cones, or pillows.

Tell children they are "preparing the way for Jesus."

They must clear the path by picking up or moving obstacles while saying kind words like "Peace," "Love," "Hope," "Joy."

This reinforces the idea that Advent is a time to prepare hearts and minds.

■ Song Suggestions

- "Prepare Ye the Way of the Lord" (Godspell simple chorus)
- "This Little Light of Mine"
- "He's Got the Whole World in His Hands"
- "Come, Thou Long-Expected Jesus" (first verse only)



- Honey & Crackers: to remember John the Baptist.
- Fruit Cups: symbolize new life and freshness.
- Water or Juice: talk about baptism and being clean inside and out.

Wrap Up & Reflections

Sit in a circle again and ask:

- What did John tell the people to do?
- How can we get ready for Jesus this week? (Let kids give answers like "pray," "be kind," "help at home.")

Say together:

"We can prepare the way for Jesus by loving others!"



A Closing Prayer

"Thank You, God, for sending Jesus, our Prince of Peace. Help us to get ready by loving You and others. Amen."



Take Home Idea

Give each child a 'Preparing for Jesus' Advent Tracker — a small sheet with 7 boxes for the

Each day they can draw or write one way they showed kindness or peace.

Encourage them to bring it back next Sunday.




Teacher Notes

- Focus on **hope and preparation**, not fear or judgment in John's message.
- Use simple language to explain Advent as "waiting and getting ready for Jesus."
- Encourage participation and movement; short attention spans thrive with rhythm and variety.
- Option: Light the second Advent candle (Peace) and explain its meaning.






