

I have quite a few photos of packed out mini vans over the years...This one is not so bad!

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




Road trip! Packing a van with 2 kiddos is much easier than 4!

I want to give a special thank you to each one of you that opened up your homes to us this past summer, it was so good to reconnect with ya'll and spend time together (you know who you are). But now, we are thankful to be home and back into our routines of life, school and work here in Sentani. We look forward to sharing more stories soon about what is going both in our lives here as well as MAF's ministry in Papua!
