What is Heartland Bible Institute?

Goals of HBI

To develop, determine, and deploy key men in key ministries and cultures that accomplish the mission of God.

HBI consists of a four year curriculum bases up-on a variety of biblical studies and ministry related training courses designed as the primary method to prepare and equip men and women who believe God has a calling on their life to full time ministry service.

Determine

HBI serves as an advanced equipping arm of like-minded churches whose mission is to equip the saints of God with the Word of God to accomplish the mission of God in the power of God, which engages experienced pastoral leaders to equip men and women of the church to function as shepherds and leaders of God's people through a structured and orderly curriculum centered in the bible.

Deploy

We will apply the knowledge of God's Word and the understanding of God's plan in the functioning of God's church leading to an outlet for ministry through evangelism, discipleship, and missions.



Structure of Institute

Classes meet here at HBF three days per week, Tuesdays, Thursdays & Saturdays. Classes consist of four 90 minute sessions between 6:30pm—8:00pm (Tuesday & Thursday) as well as 7:30am—10:45am (Saturday).

The four years are divided into two semesters per year. All classes are offered online.

Graduation requirements: passing grades in all classes. Mission/Discipleship trip, pastor evaluation, dissertation, special projects as assigned throughout the four years of study, service team participation as directed.
