

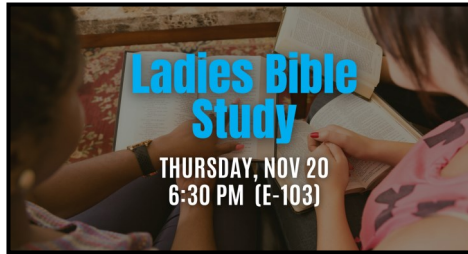


WELCOMES YOU TO OUR MORNING WORSHIP
