# Arranging the Service

As soon as you are able, please contact the church office to discuss possible dates and times. The officiating minister will meet with you and your family members to provide pastoral care and to plan the service (e.g., confirming the order, identifying eulogists, choosing hymns, and selecting an appropriate Scripture passage).

## Working with a Funeral Home

If you have chosen a funeral home, the funeral director will assist with all the necessary legal requirements. Please let the church office know which funeral home you'll be working with as well as the name and contact information of the funeral director.

## Visual Tributes / Photo Slideshows

If you would like to include a visual tribute as part of the service, please note that you will need to create or arrange for this and provide a finished version (with music embedded). We are not able to build slideshows from photo collections or digital picture files, as this is a task best suited to a family member. Please speak to Rev. Sam about format requirements.

# Funeral Tea Ministry

Our Funeral Tea Ministry is made up of volunteers to help serve you at your time of grief and loss. These volunteers provide a two-hour reception following the funeral service. At the reception, tea, coffee, juice, and a selection of light refreshments will be served. When you are able, please provide approximate numbers to the office, as this greatly helps with planning and preparation.

#### **Funeral Costs**

We will send you an invoice following the service for all applicable fees, which are calculated at-cost according to the schedule on the reverse of this brochure. Payment can be made via cheque or etransfer. If you are experiencing financial hardship and the fees present a barrier, please speak to the minister.
